We aim to respond to your request as soon as possible. These requests are complex in nature, and we endeavour to respond promptly and, in any case, within three months of receipt. We apologise for the delay and any problems this causes.

National Records of Scotland (NRS) holds records on behalf of SG who you also sent this request to. These records include exempt/closed government files relating to approved and List D schools, children's homes, and prison and borstal services. SG remain the data controller for these records and makes all decisions on access.

The SG Information Assurance and Data Protection Branch mailbox at dpa@gov.scot and the team will coordinate searches of these records and respond to you directly.

NRS will respond to you about any other records relevant to your requests, including open government files, other prison and borstal records, and court records.
