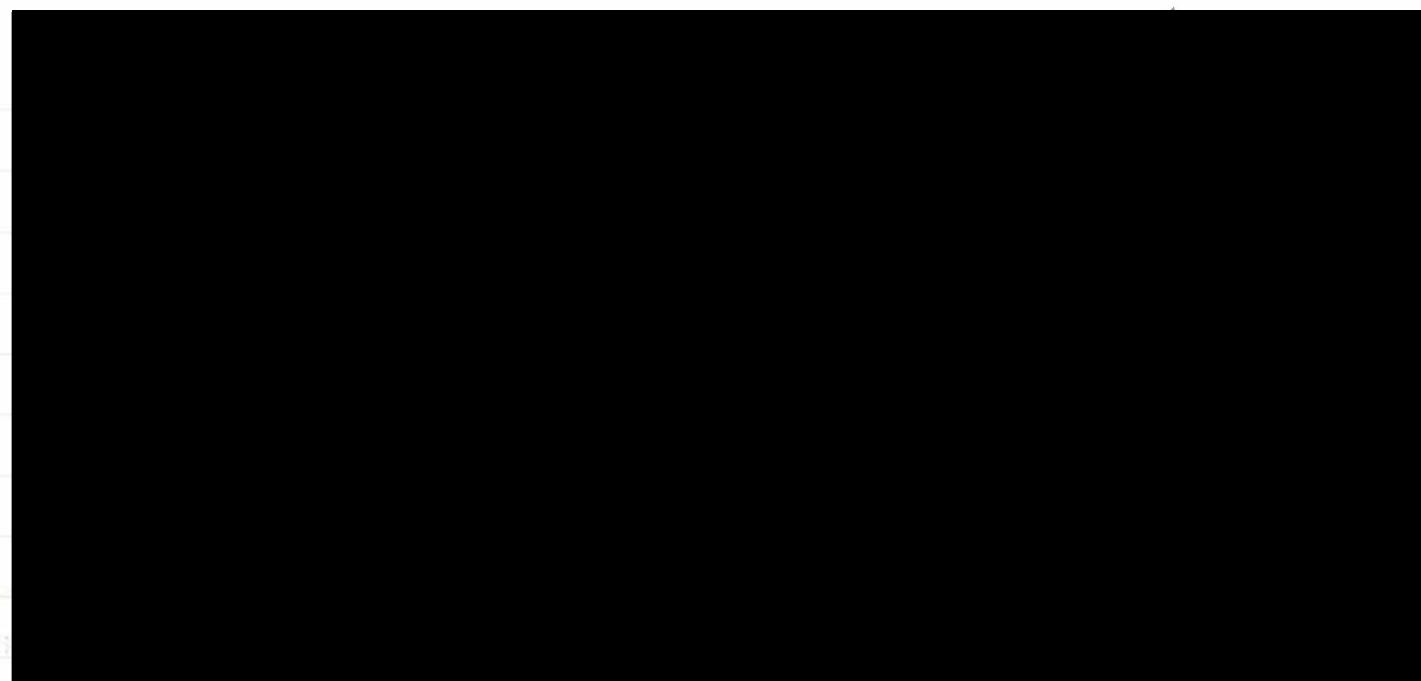
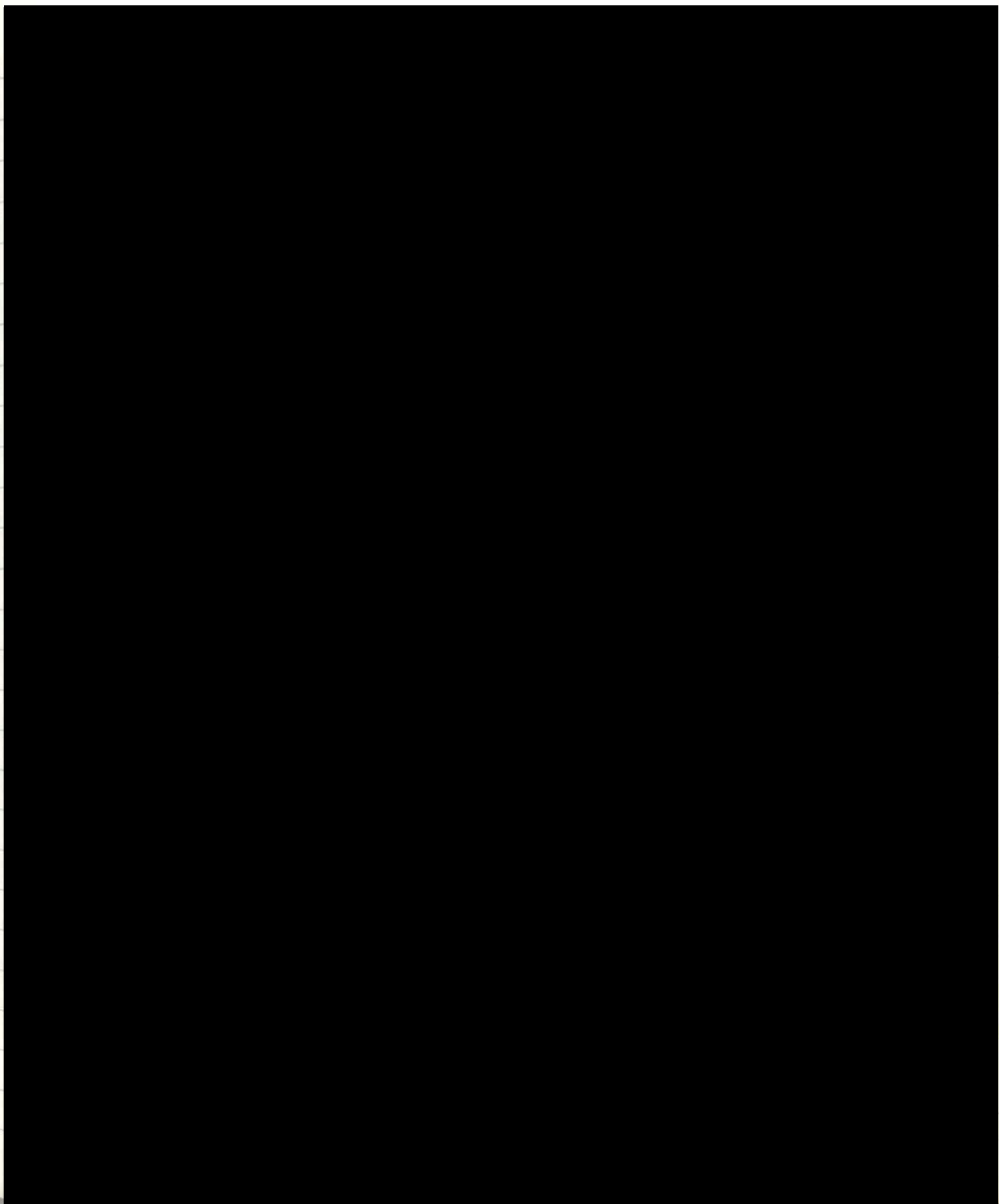
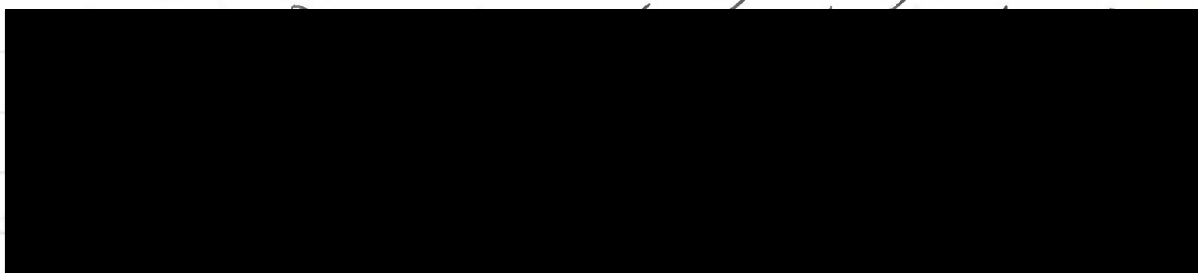




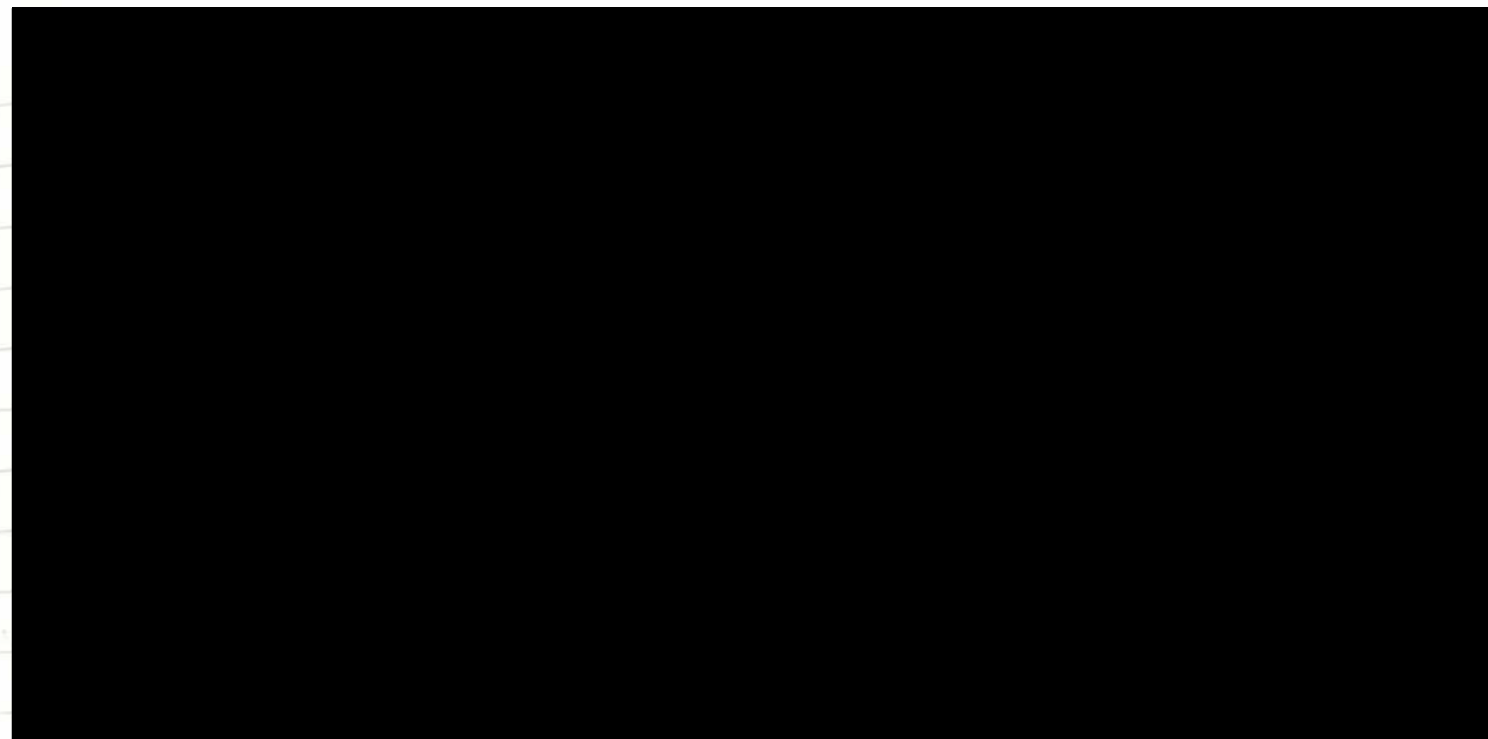
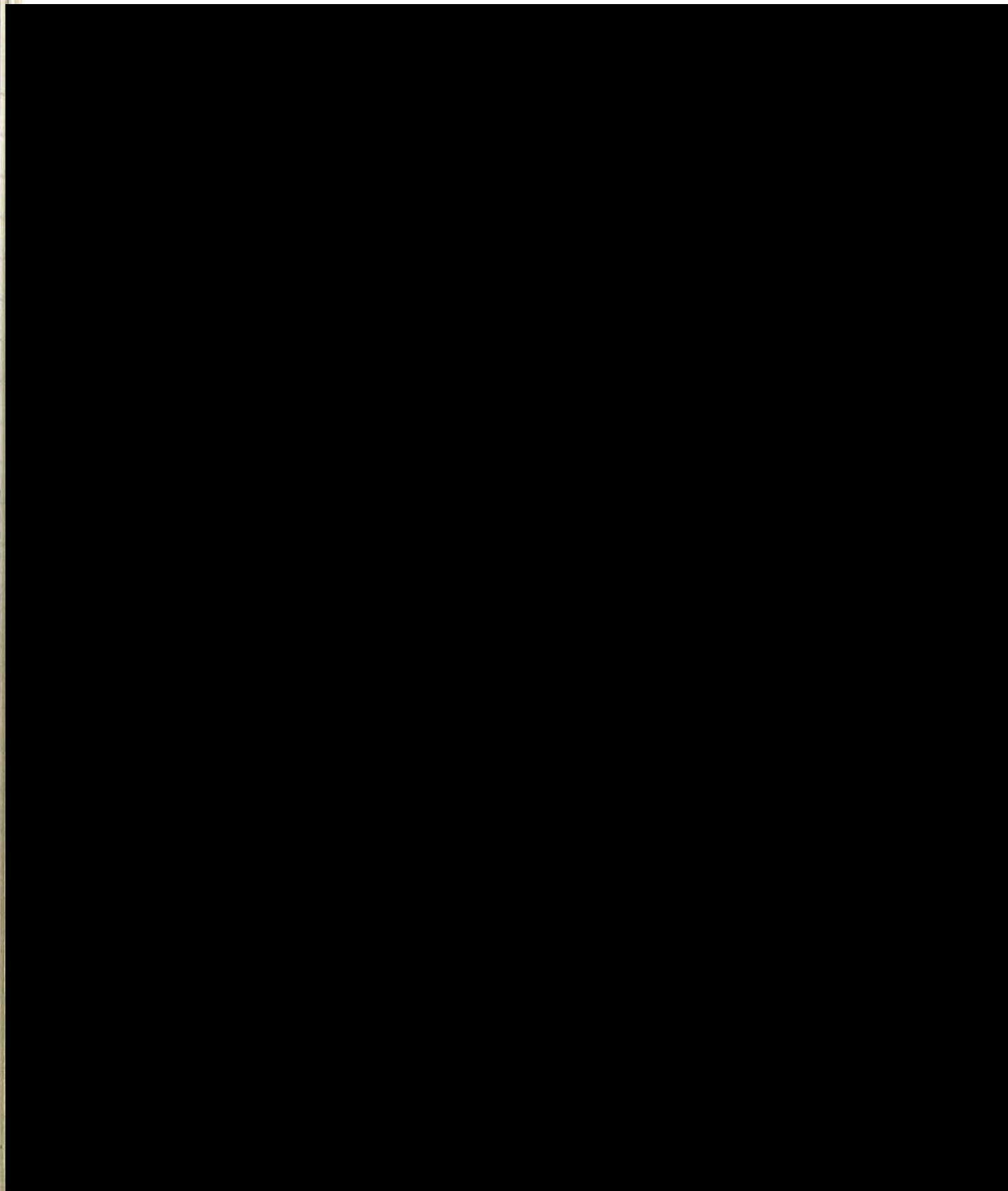
14.2.92 Mark Johnson was at the doctors today

 fluids until he feels better.



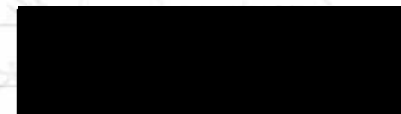
20.2.92 I telephoned Mrs Hamilton, Health Visitor re

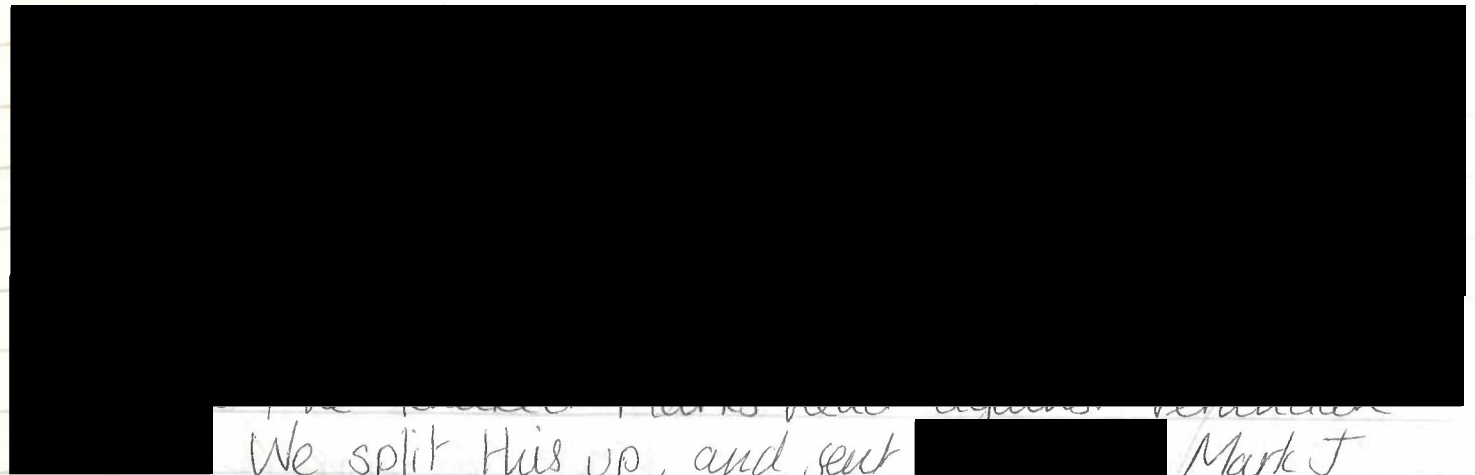
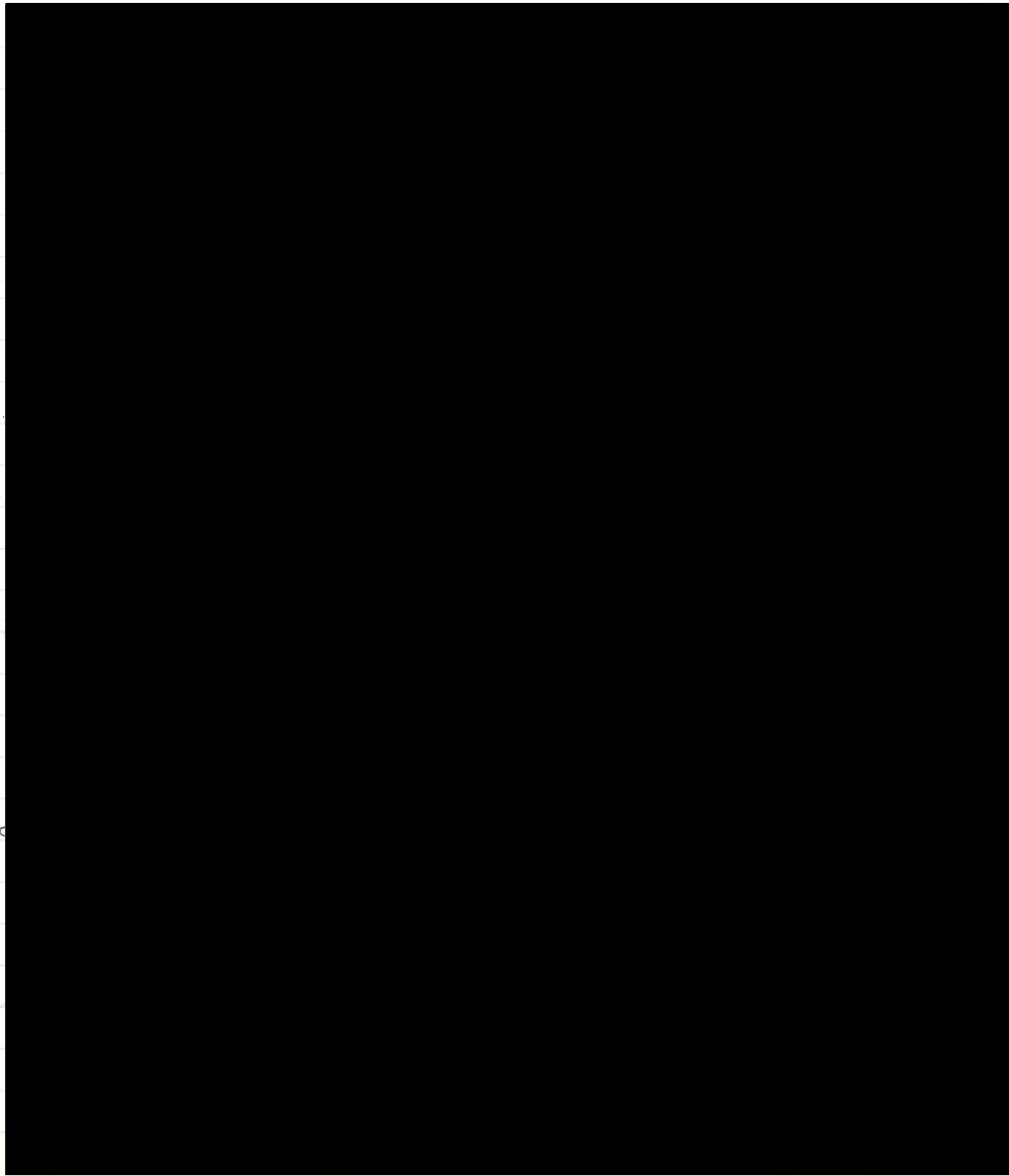


27/4/92 Mark J "fell out" with [redacted] at 8.45pm. He

almost immediately. [REDACTED] JGH

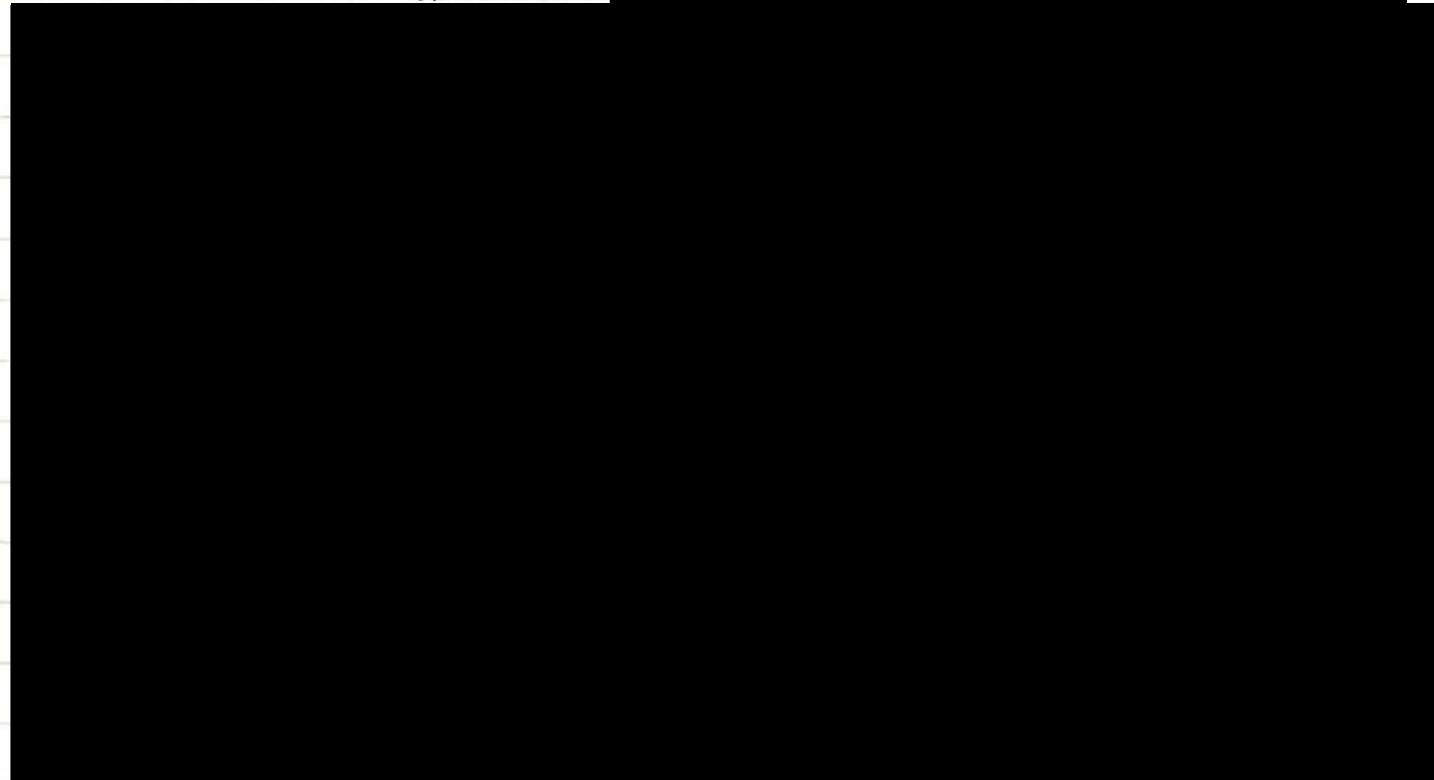
