

20/9/92 Weekend Camp - Owenstone/Rosslyn. Sunday - Swimming
 at Cupar Pool - Mark J dived in at the shallow
 end & cracked his head off the bottom. He
 split his forehead & lost quite a bit of
 blood. He was attended to by the first aider
 at the pool. Took him to casualty ^(Victoria) where he
 received 4 paper stitches & an x-ray. I took
 him home & told mum to keep him at home
 for 2 days. Taxi would collect him on
 Wednesday morning.

25/9/92. Mark Johnson was removed from class by Jay in the afternoon. When he returned he kicked over & threw some items of furniture and had to be restrained. He calmed down and carried on as normal. J. Fairlie.

28/9 Fairly lengthy period of restraint required for Mark Johnson who was right out of line threatening damage to himself and determined to abscond. Mrs Scott eventually provided the "new face" necessary to defuse the situation. Mark attempted to re-open his head wound and in the initial chaos of his outburst caused extensive bruising to Mrs Smith's arm.

23/11/92 - Mark Johnston absconded from class this ^{2:30}pm. Viv & Mary went to look for him as Viv had received a call from Ovenshott house saying he was heading towards Pailfield - came back could not find him - we phoned police with description of Mark. Mark appeared back in school by his own volition around 3:10pm closely followed by Police - we apologised to Police for inconvenience - Mark said nothing.

23/11/92 Mark was told he would be taken home.

At 4:15pm he went into "full flight" + had to be restrained for his own safety. He was determined to abscond + he was also determined to "self destruct" (head banging, scratching etc etc). His "full-flight" lasted a whole hour, then subsided, then re-started again for another hour.

After having left a message for Mrs Johnston (who was out!) she eventually returned the call at 6:45pm. Cameron spoke to Mr Cameron who agreed Mark would go home for 2 days. The bus will collect him on Thursday morning. The GP was called out to check Mark - he was ^(7pm) happy with him (we did this partly to cover our own backs!) Mark told the Dr to 'fack off'.

During Mark's performance he was extremely verbally + physically aggressive - swearing, kicking, punching, biting, nipping etc etc. Cameron + I eventually took him home at 7:15pm. Mum wasn't very happy about Mark returning - obviously an inconvenience! A case conference is to be called. JGH

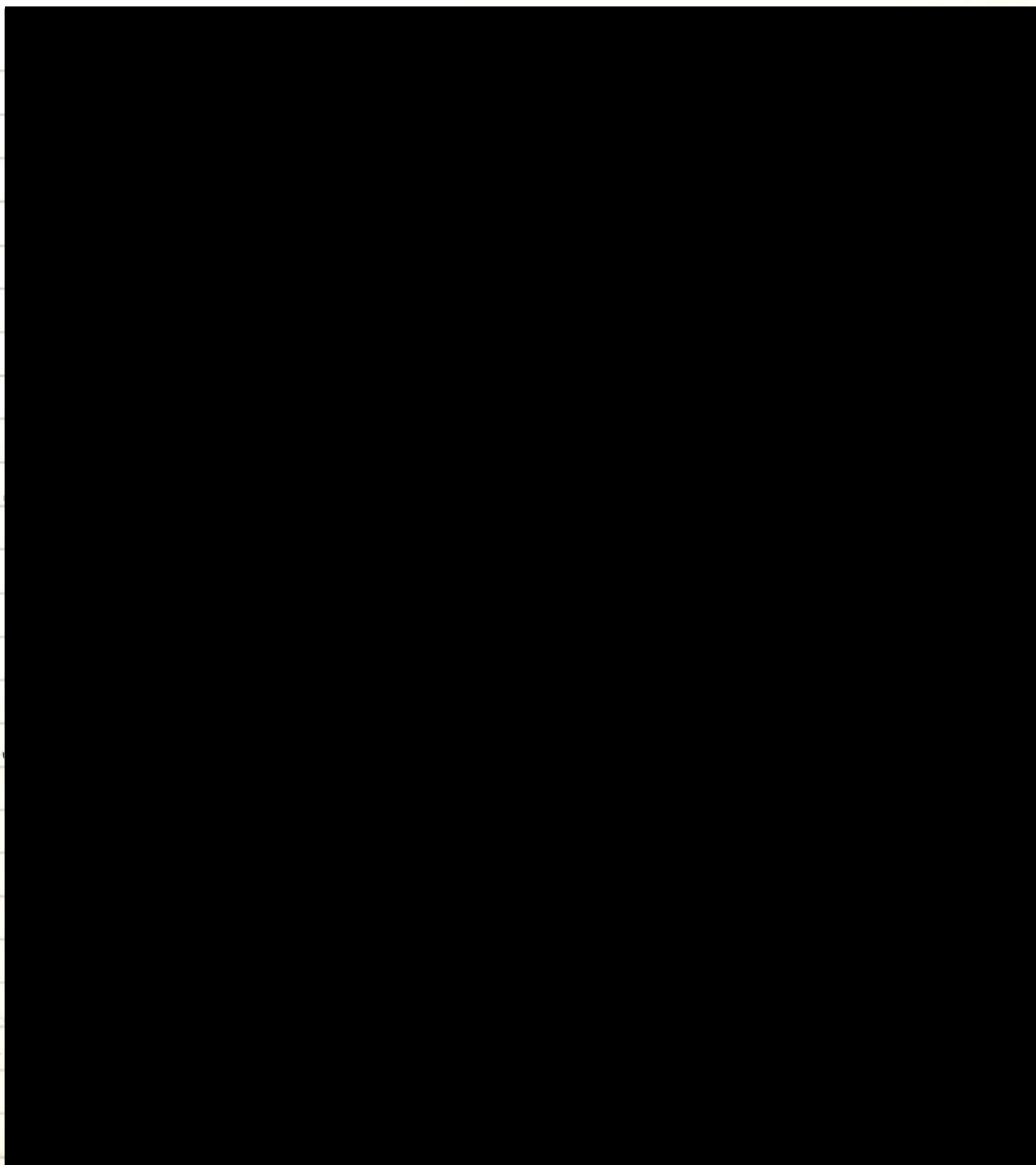
also taught them how to make looks!

16/12/92 Mark Johnstone over-reacted to a comment made by [REDACTED] on the bus - the bus had to be stopped and Mark restrained. The bus returned to school to drop off the two boys concerned with the incident.
