What the Survivor shared with me

AT THE BEGINNING, Sally was very WITHDRAWING AND QUIET AND KEPT A LOT OF WHAT HAPPENED TO HERSELF. AS THE YEARS WENT ON SHE STARTED TO OPEN UP ABOUT THINGS THAT HAPPENED TO HER. SHE STILL KEEPS HER BARRIERS UP. SHE HAS TOLD ME THAT WHEN SHE WAS YOUNG, THAT SHE WITNESSED A LOT OF ABUSE. SHE TOLD ME SHE WAS HIT, PUNCHED, MADE TO GO IN COLD BATHS FOR THE SOAP. FORCED TO EAT WITH ^{SOAPS} ~~SOUP~~ FOOD AND WHEN SHE WAS SICK SHE WAS FORCED TO EAT WHAT SHE BROUGHT UP, WAS FORCED TO STAND FOR HOURS IN A CORNER, AND NOT SPEAK TO ANYONE.

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Impact on the Survivor I have observed

Every Day Living, with Sally has its ups and downs as she suffers flashbacks, and goes into her own wee world.

Always has a smile on her face as this is away of masking things - she turned to drink at night to block out the abuse and is on Citalopram 20mg, and also Digulfram 200mg. To help her come off the drink. Some weeks she does fine other times she will fall back into the drink. I thank her way of dealing with it.
