Your statement for additional care settings

Q1 | What is the name or location of the relevant care setting you were abused in?

(For example, the name of the care home, or the city or region where you lived in foster care or while boarded out).

Q2 | When were you abused?

For example: a single date, an age, or an approximate time or time range.

Q3 | Who was involved in your abuse?

For example: a member of staff, a peer or someone outside the care setting.

The information you provide will be used by Redress Scotland to make a decision about your application. Redress Scotland will use the "Assessment framework" to help them do this, available on [gov.scot](https://www.gov.scot). Please be aware that it contains graphic descriptions of abuse.

Q4 | On the next page, please provide as much information as you can about:

- the abuse you experienced while living in this care setting
- what life was like for you during this time
- how the people responsible for your care and welfare failed to carry out that duty (within or beyond your care setting)

Your statement for additional care settings

I was placed here when I was 13 years old.

This was a bad experience for me. I got battered and abused. I got pulled out of my bed at night by other kids here and this wasn't nice at all. They would pull me out, beat me up and then run away.

I had great fear here, The officers were no better. They would assault me too for no reason at all. They would also come in to my room and pull me out of bed too. This started nightmares for me which wasn't nice to suffer from being 13 years old. Officers would grab me and others at any random times and give us a knuckle to the temple and this used to really hurt me.

There would come times were I'd be too upset to even eat my food as this was a horrible experience to go through.
