Q1 | What is the name or location of the relevant care setting you were abused in?

(For example, the name of the care home, or the city or region where you lived in foster care or while boarded out).

Your statement for additional care settings

During my time in foster care, my foster carer misused my disability benefits by spending the money on her other children instead of using it for my needs, she stole my money.

While I was living there, I was kidnapped from outside the house. I was drugged, taken to a house, tied up in the attic, and sexually assaulted. I managed to bang my foot through the floorboards to try to alert the police to where I was being held. I was found in the attic, naked and still under the effects of drugs.

It has since been revealed that my foster carer knew who was responsible for what happened to me and failed to protect me or take action to prevent it. She knew what he was going to do to me and allowed it to occur.
