Your statement for additional care settings

In Part 1, you will have already provided information about the care settings you were abused in. By providing this information here, your case worker can join together the name of the care setting with your statement of abuse.

Q1 | What is the name or location of the relevant care setting you were abused in?

(For example, the name of the care home, or the city or region where you lived in foster care or while boarded out).

Q2 | When were you abused?

For example: a single date, an age, or an approximate time or time range.

Q3 | Who was involved in your abuse?

For example: a member of staff, a peer or someone outside the care setting.

Q4 | On the next page, please provide as much information as you can about:

- the abuse you experienced while living in this care setting
- what life was like for you during this time
- how the people responsible for your care and welfare failed to carry out that duty (within or beyond your care setting)

Your statement for additional care settings

When I was placed here I was 11/12 years old. The staff members were no help nor pleasant any way. I was also bullied here a lot and it resulted in me running away from this care setting 3-4 times.

When we used to get the home leave I always extended my leave and postponed going back as much as I could as I really didn't like this place at all.

Another one of the boy's who were at this care setting smashed a glass bottle over my head which resulted in my head splitting open and needing medical attention to get stitches.

I was also beaten up quite a lot here too and this really affecting me in my time here.

The staff members here didn't care and their own duty of care for us kids was below par. One staff member also slapped me in the face and punched me in the head for them not helping me so with my reaction, that's what I got.
