Your statement for additional care settings

I was placed here I was around 14 years old. I was placed here for not going to school. This was not a good place to be in for me.

I was shouted out at a lot and when I look back at it, this was for nothing. I wasn't a naughty child. I was restrained and hurt by this, I was restrained by 2-3 staff members at a time. This caused injuries of sore arms, being twisted up by my arms and I would feel knee's and elbows digging in to me.
To me, I didn't deserve to suffer this physical abuse.
