

Review of SAR-A-Martin GP Records

Scope: 417-page iGPR record supplied in two PDF parts. The schedule below records the entries identified as most relevant to the requested abuse, mental-health, treatment, substance-use, impact and third-party-record categories. No clear documentary evidence of childhood placement in care was identified in the searchable GP consultation record. The reference to Balcarres Residential Home appears in an employment context and should not be treated as placement evidence without independent confirmation.

Part 1 p.57 (internal 57)	21-Aug-2008	Mental health / impact	Poor sleep and agitation recorded during ongoing pain; patient felt citalopram had stimulant-like effects.	No abuse link recorded; Impact / treatment

Part 1 p.52 (internal 52)	16-Mar-2012	Social impact / neutral mental health	Recorded unfit for work and receiving sickness/invalidity benefit; depression screening recorded as no.	No abuse link; Impact / contradictory-neutral
Part 1 p.102 (internal 102)	29-Apr-2024	Physical consequence / employment injury	Long-standing worsening pain and falls; record attributes slipped disc in neck to accident while working in a care home in 2007.	Explicitly linked to workplace accident, not childhood abuse; Physical impact / treatment
Part 2 p.3-4 (internal 306-307)	27-May-2014	Third-party pain report / medication	Pain clinic report records chronic neck, back and leg pain, restless sleep, and use of sertraline and amitriptyline alongside analgesics.	No abuse link recorded; Treatment / impact

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Part 2 p.7-8 (internal 310-311)	25-Aug-2014	Long-term social impact / third-party report	Orthopaedic report records she had not worked for seven years and was receiving benefit; previously worked as a carer in a care home.	No abuse link recorded; Impact
Part 2 p.12-13 (internal 315-316)	19-Dec-2014	Pain treatment / third-party report	Pain clinic review records chronic neck and back pain, medication including gabapentin, tramadol and baclofen, and gradual improvement.	No abuse link recorded; Treatment / impact
Part 2 p.14 (internal 317)	05-May-2015	Missed appointment	Patient failed to attend physiotherapy and was discharged.	No trauma link recorded; Neutral / treatment access
Part 2 p.16 (internal 319)	09-Jun-2015	Missed appointments	Removed from physiotherapy waiting list after two letters and no contact.	No trauma link recorded; Neutral / treatment access

Important limitation: Part 2 consists mainly of scanned images. Relevant third-party letters were visually reviewed and marked, but poor scan quality and incomplete machine-readable text mean that handwritten or faint wording may require a further manual page-by-page legal review before filing.
