

EVIDENCE EXTRACTION SHEET

Kevin McGowan - Scottish Redress document review

Documents reviewed	6 supplied PDFs (292 pages total)
Review scope	Placement/eligibility, abuse indicators, disclosures, institutional response, impact, substance use, education/life impact, contradictions and page-reference schedule.
Method	Scanned pages were reviewed visually and with OCR assistance. Handwritten or unclear material is identified as such. Findings are limited to what the supplied documents support.

Important evidential qualification

The records contain direct proof of care placement and direct records of physical restraint. They also contain a contemporaneous record of a reported childhood rape, but do not identify where that rape occurred or who perpetrated it. Later records say Kevin denied making that statement. The report therefore does not describe the rape as proven or as having occurred at Kibble. Likewise, recorded restraints are not labelled "abuse" unless the source says so.

Findings by requested category

1. Proof of placement and eligibility

- Name consistently recorded as Kevin McGowan; DOB 09/04/1986. No former name was located in the reviewed records.
- Kibble Education and Care Centre / Kibble School, Goudie Street, Paisley PA3 2LG is repeatedly identified. Internal units include Mossedge South, Clydevue/Clyde View, and a database-coded Mossway entry.
- Paper records support initial residential admission on 10/02/2000 for a 22-day Section 69 assessment. A Children's Hearing on 27/03/2000 varied the order to Section 70(3)(a). Review records proposed ending the Residential Order at the 07/06/2000 Panel and moving to Extended Day / home.
- Inverclyde Social Work Services is recorded as supervising authority; Inverclyde Education Services confirmed funding of the Extended Day placement. Named staff include Harry Scott, Stella Sneddon, Bill Miller, Alasdair Black, David MacAleer, Anita Carvalho and others listed in review minutes.
- Database evidence records Clyde View 16/02/2000-07/06/2000, Mossway 13/06/2000-15/06/2000, release 15/06/2000 to home. Paper records use 10/02/2000 as Kibble admission and show Extended Day activity beginning in June.

2. Direct evidence of physical abuse / force

- No record located explicitly characterises staff conduct as physical abuse, unauthorised restraint or assault upon Kevin.
- There are direct records of physical restraint. On 14/02/2000 Kevin was restrained using TCI and then restrained again for about 10 minutes after further aggression. On 20/09/2000 he was restrained after lashing out; during the restraint his head hit the ground, causing a forehead bump.
- The records frame these restraints as responses to Kevin's aggression. The extraction sheet therefore records the events and injury without classifying the force as abusive.

3. Direct evidence of sexual abuse

- A 31/10/2000 follow-up records a third-party account that Kevin said he had told police he had been “raped as a small boy”, and that this related to his reaction when touched by teacher Keiron Gildea.
- The location, alleged perpetrator and circumstances of the reported childhood rape are not identified in these records, and no record located states that the rape occurred at Kibble or another named care setting.
- Later records state Kevin denied making the rape statement to his mother and social worker. This inconsistency is preserved and should be addressed rather than omitted.

4. Emotional or psychological abuse / impact

- No clear direct record located of staff humiliating, threatening or emotionally abusing Kevin.
- Records do document low self-worth, being quiet/withdrawn and uncomfortable on admission, later sullen/withdrawn presentation, anger around perceived invasion of personal space, and marked apathy in November 2000.
- These are evidence of emotional/behavioural presentation and impact, not by themselves proof that staff caused psychological abuse.

5. Neglect

- No clear direct evidence located of inadequate food, clothing, hygiene, medical care or routine family contact while resident at Kibble.
- Contemporaneous reports instead record healthy appetite/regular meals, daily bathing and dental hygiene, an admission medical without problems, parental visits, telephone contact and extensive home leave.
- Parents did state that lack of Education/Social Work support before Kibble contributed to Kevin's difficulties; this is recorded as their view rather than an independent finding of neglect.

6. Contemporaneous disclosures and complaints

- The key disclosure is the 31/10/2000 rape statement reported by peer Darren McNally to Bill Miller. Records say Kevin allegedly told the peer that he had told police he had been raped as a small boy.
- INFORM minutes dated 22/11/2000 record the same sexually related childhood experience, the subsequent denial, discussion with parents and agreement that fuller clarification should be sought.
- Handwritten COSS contacts record follow-up with parents/social work and Kevin's repeated denial.

7. Institutional knowledge and failure to act

- The supplied records show Kibble/COSS, social work and parents became aware of the reported childhood sexual experience and discussed it; INFORM agreed fuller clarification should be sought.
- No record located in the supplied material shows a Kibble staff member was identified as the perpetrator, or that a staff disciplinary/police investigation into sexual misconduct at Kibble occurred.
- No clear evidence located of previous similar complaints against the same employee, regulatory findings, record destruction or management pressure to withdraw a complaint.

8. Frequency, duration and pattern

- Absconding/missing episodes were repeated, especially 20/04-01/05/2000 and again during the Extended Day period. Police, parents and social work were repeatedly notified and Kevin was returned on several occasions.
- Behaviour and school attendance deteriorated during Extended Day. The 31/10/2000 event was described as Kevin's third staff assault and preceded suspension/exclusion.
- The sexual-abuse disclosure does not state frequency or duration of the alleged childhood rape. Physical restraint is documented in more than one incident but not described as a routine punishment.

9. Mental-health and psychological impact

- Records document low self-worth, withdrawal, poor motivation, anger, apathy and concern about possible underlying psychological/organic factors. There is no formal PTSD/depression diagnosis in the supplied record set reviewed for this task.
- Kevin's behaviour was repeatedly linked to non-attendance, absconding, conflict with authority and difficulty communicating feelings.

10. Physical and medical consequences

- The clearest injury is the forehead bump sustained when Kevin's head hit the ground during restraint on 20/09/2000. No treatment is recorded in the identified entry.
- Other health records in the placement describe Kevin as generally fit and healthy with no major medical concerns.

11. Substance use and coping mechanisms

- Records repeatedly refer to smoking, alcohol and cannabis, with later references to possible drug use/acid and returning home under the influence.
- No record located expressly links Kevin's substance use to coping with sexual abuse or trauma. Causation should therefore not be assumed.

12. Education, relationships and life impact

- Kevin experienced exclusion from Wellington Academy and Gourock High, Mearns Centre support, Kibble residential education, Extended Day attendance difficulties, and eventual exclusion from Kibble education after November 2000.
- Records describe family stress, repeated nights away, police involvement, offending and later recommendation for another residential school placement.
- Education reports show ability in some subjects but low motivation/attendance and attainment below age expectations in parts of the curriculum.

13. Evidence that apparently contradicts or qualifies the account

- Admission dates differ by record type: paper Kibble records commonly state 10/02/2000; the Kibble database and IEP use 16/02/2000 for Clyde View. The latter corresponds to the documented transfer to Clydeview after initial days in South/Mossedge.
- The database records release to home on 15/06/2000, while review records expected residential termination around 07/06/2000 and Extended Day commencement immediately. A database-coded Mossyway stay 13-15/06/2000 may explain part of the overlap but is not explained in the papers.
- The alleged rape statement was later denied by Kevin. Both the original disclosure and denial must be retained.
- Several records describe Kevin as settled, healthy and presenting no management problems in Clydeview, despite significant absconding/offending episodes and later deterioration. These positive records do not erase adverse events but are important qualification.

14. Page-reference schedule

- The detailed schedule below records the source PDF page, internal page/date where identifiable, author/role, care setting, factual extract, evidential relevance and document form. Highlighted copies of all six source PDFs are supplied separately.

Evidence type terminology: "Direct" means the record itself documents the event/placement; "corroborative" means it supports context or impact; "third-party disclosure" records what someone was reported to have said and is not treated as independent proof of the underlying event.

Key gaps and unresolved points

- No former name located.
- No clear document in this set identifies a staff member or resident as perpetrator of sexual abuse against Kevin at Kibble. The rape reference is to an unspecified childhood event and was later denied by Kevin.
- No direct record located of food deprivation, inadequate clothing, poor hygiene, untreated injury, or denial of routine family contact during the Kibble residential period. Several records positively document adequate basic care.
- No clear record located of a formal investigation outcome into the childhood rape disclosure, beyond discussion with parents/social work and an agreement to seek fuller clarification.
- Exact admission/discharge dates for Ballikinrain and St John's are not contained in the selected records. Ballikinrain appears to have been an assessment/short stay in early January 2001; St John's is confirmed only as a current placement by 08/07/2001.
- Page 91 of Combined docs 2 contains an apparent wording/date inconsistency: it says Kibble admission 10/02/00 but later says admission to Mossedge South "Thursday 10 March"; the surrounding incident dates and other records support February 2000. This report does not silently correct the source.
