Your statement for additional care settings

Q1 | What is the name or location of the relevant care setting you were abused in?

(For example, the name of the care home, or the city or region where you lived in foster care or while boarded out).

- the abuse you experienced while living in this care setting
- what life was like for you during this time
- how the people responsible for your care and welfare failed to carry out that duty (within or beyond your care setting)

Your statement for additional care settings

This was my second foster placement. I was around 5 or 6 years old when I was placed there with my sister, Amy. The foster carers had an older biological daughter, and the abuse I experienced came from her.

She would physically hurt both me and my sister. She would come into the room and hit us, and on some occasions she would dig the heels of her shoes into our shins. I also remember being told to get out of the car and walk.

The foster carers were aware of the way their daughter was treating us, but they did not do anything to stop it or protect us. Their daughter was older than me
