Review scope. The source report itself states a selected date range of **1 May 2023 to 4 August 2026**. It is therefore an adult GP extract, not a childhood-era medical file. The findings below describe only what is identifiable in this PDF and do not imply that evidence is absent from other GP, hospital, social-work or historical records.

Executive findings

Area	Finding
Evidence of placement in care	No relevant entry identified. No children's home, residential school, foster placement, assessment centre, institutional childhood address, supervision requirement, house parent, residential staff or childhood social-work placement reference was identified in this PDF.
Physical / sexual / emotional abuse	No direct or indirect care-setting abuse disclosure identified in this PDF. No assault, corporal punishment, sexual abuse, grooming, fear of care staff, or abuse-linked childhood injury wording was identified.
Neglect / contemporaneous disclosure	No relevant childhood neglect or contemporaneous abuse disclosure identified.
Mental health / self-harm / suicide	No relevant mental-health diagnosis, trauma/PTSD entry, psychiatric treatment, self-harm, suicidal ideation/attempt or mental-health medication entry identified in the reviewed PDF.
Substance / alcohol use	Neutral adult entries only: "Drinks occasionally" (p.5); "Alcohol intake within recommended sensible limits" (pp.14 and 22). Tobacco history is recorded as ex-smoker, with current vaping on p.5.
Third-party / attached records	The GP report records several hospital/clinic letters, including ARI Diabetic Clinic (p.6), an out-of-area A&E; hospital letter and attached hospital letter (p.14), and ARI Dietetics & Nutrition (p.16). These are adult medical records and do not provide care/abuse evidence in the entries reviewed.
Historic records status	Page 25 states "Total notes on computer NO PAPER RECORS" and separately records "Historical Filing Back Scanned records". This is relevant when considering whether earlier/historic material may need to be sought separately or clarified with the practice.

Category-by-category review

1. Evidence of placement in care

No relevant evidence identified in the 2023-2026 GP extract.

2. Physical abuse and injuries

No care-related assault, corporal punishment, unexplained childhood injury, or injury attributed to staff/residents identified.

3. Sexual abuse

No explicit or indirect reference identified. No sexual-abuse-linked medical indicator was identified as such by the record.

4. Emotional or psychological abuse

No care-setting humiliation, threats, fear of staff, fear of return, or abuse-linked emotional deterioration identified.

5. Neglect

No childhood medical, physical, emotional or safeguarding neglect identified. Adult DNAs in the file are not treated as evidence of childhood neglect.

6. Contemporaneous disclosures

No contemporaneous childhood disclosure of abuse, fear, unsafe care, excessive punishment or running away due to treatment identified.

7. Mental-health conditions and symptoms

No depression, anxiety, PTSD/trauma, panic, flashbacks, nightmares, dissociation, psychosis or comparable mental-health condition identified in the reviewed extract.

8. Mental-health medication

No antidepressant, anxiolytic, antipsychotic, mood stabiliser, sedative or trauma/nightmare medication identified.

9. Counselling, therapy and psychiatric care

No counselling, psychology, psychotherapy, EMDR, psychiatric/CMHT/CAMHS/crisis-team or survivor-support entry identified.

10. Self-harm and suicide

No self-harm, suicidal thought/intent/plan/attempt, intentional overdose, welfare check or psychiatric crisis entry identified.

11. Substance and alcohol use

Neutral adult findings only: occasional alcohol / within sensible limits; ex-smoker and current vaping. No alcohol dependence, illicit drug use, opioid dependence, methadone/buprenorphine, overdose, detox or rehabilitation identified.

12. Physical consequences in adulthood

No later condition is linked in this PDF to childhood abuse, neglect or a care-setting assault.

13. Long-term personal and social impact

No social consequence is explicitly linked to childhood abuse/care. Work-away/offshore employment is documented but not presented as abuse-related impact.

14. Third-party and attached records

Adult hospital/clinic letters are referenced on pp.6, 14 and 16. Page 25 also references "Historical Filing Back Scanned records". No psychiatric, psychology, social-work, police/court, child-protection or school-medical report was identified in the text review.

15. Contradictory or neutral entries

Relevant neutral findings include alcohol use described as occasional/within sensible limits. No abuse allegation was identified for which a denial, retraction or "unsubstantiated" finding could be compared.

16. Recommended extraction schedule

See the page-reference schedule below for every entry retained as potentially relevant to the requested framework.

Page-reference extraction schedule

The schedule deliberately excludes unrelated adult clinical entries and does not reinterpret routine missed appointments as childhood neglect.

Care setting/perpetrator: none. Link to abuse: none. Evidential value: defines the temporal scope and explains why childhood-era evidence is not expected in this extract.

Evidence: Ex smoker currently vapes; Drinks occasionally.

Care setting/perpetrator: none. Link to abuse: none. Evidential value: neutral adult substance history only.

Evidence: Letter received Hospital Letter ARI Diabetic Clinic.

Care setting/perpetrator: none. Link to abuse: none. Evidential value: adult hospital correspondence; no care/abuse content identified in the index entry.

PDF p.14 | 30-May-2025 | Miss Emma Howie | Substance/alcohol - neutral

Evidence: Alcohol intake within recommended sensible limits; ex-smoker.

Care setting/perpetrator: none. Link to abuse: none. Evidential value: neutral adult substance history only.

PDF p.14 | 12-13 May 2025 | GP administration / hospital correspondence | Third-party record

Evidence: Outpatient clinic letter received 12.05.25; patient email with hospital letter attached; discharged from hospital - Out Of Area Hospital Accident & Emergency.

Care setting/perpetrator: none. Link to abuse: none. Evidential value: adult hospital correspondence; no care/abuse content identified in the index entries.

PDF p.16 | 17-Sept-2024 | Mrs Susan Robertson / ARI | Third-party record

Evidence: Administration Hospital Letter Aberdeen Royal Infirmary - Dietetics & Nutrition.

Care setting/perpetrator: none. Link to abuse: none. Evidential value: adult dietetics correspondence; no care/abuse content identified.

PDF p.22 | 04-Sept-2023 | Ms Paula Reid | Substance/alcohol - neutral

Evidence: Ex smoker; Alcohol intake within recommended sensible limits.

Care setting/perpetrator: none. Link to abuse: none. Evidential value: neutral adult substance history only.

PDF p.25 | 17-May-2023 | Mrs Carol Anderson / System Supervisor | Historic records status

Evidence: Total notes on computer NO PAPER RECORDS; Historical Filing Back Scanned records.

Care setting/perpetrator: none. Link to abuse: none. Evidential value: records-management point. Follow-up: clarify whether any pre-computer childhood records were scanned, transferred, destroyed, or are held elsewhere.

Review notes and limitations

- The review is confined to the attached 261-page GP Subject Access Request. It does not incorporate the earlier social-work SAR documents unless they are reproduced within this GP PDF.
- No inference of abuse, neglect or trauma has been made from ordinary adult symptoms or appointments where the record does not make that connection.
- “No relevant entry identified” means none was located in this PDF after text review and targeted checking; it is not a statement that the event or condition never occurred.
- The highlighted source copy marks the limited entries retained in this extraction sheet: report date range, neutral alcohol/substance history, adult hospital-letter references, and historic-records status.
