Key findings and limitations

Placement in care	Explicitly recorded in EMIS documents pages 2 and 13. One record states a care home between ages 13 and 15; another states her mother placed her into care at 13 and she remained until 16. No institution is named in these healthcare entries.
Sexual abuse	EMIS documents page 2 records the patient reporting childhood sexual abuse. The reviewed entry does not name a perpetrator, institution, dates or safeguarding response.
Physical abuse	No directly confirmed childhood-care physical-abuse disclosure was identified in the entries extracted. NHS GGC 2 pages 51-52 record an adult report of assault causing shoulder/elbow injury, but no care connection.
Emotional abuse and neglect	No directly confirmed healthcare entry describing institutional emotional abuse or neglect was identified in the extracted pages. Trauma symptoms, low mood, anxiety, negative beliefs, emotional numbness and dissociation are evidence of impact, not by themselves proof of the source.
Mental health, therapy and self-harm	The strongest entries are EMIS documents pages 1-3 and 12-13, EMIS consultations page 1, and NHS GGC pages 11, 13, 15, 23, 29-30 and 43-45.
Substance use	Records document longstanding alcohol excess/dependence, addiction-service involvement, binge drinking, use of alcohol to cope with bereavements/anniversaries and difficult emotions, and later abstinence. Only the explicit clinical statements have been recorded; no unsupported causal link to childhood abuse has been added.
Contradictory or neutral evidence	The 2010 psychiatric assessment records stable/reactive mood, no psychosis or psychiatric symptomatology and little/no suicidal ideation at interview. The 2011 overdose records later state no suicidal ideation and low risk at discharge. These are included as negative findings, not omitted.
