Your statement for additional care settings

Q4 | On the next page, please provide as much information as you can about:

- the abuse you experienced while living in this care setting
- what life was like for you during this time
- how the people responsible for your care and welfare failed to carry out that duty (within or beyond your care setting)

You can continue on additional pages if you need to.

Your statement for additional care settings

I was running away from home all the time. I was breaking into cars and stealing, and my mum could no longer cope, so I was placed there. While I was living there, I did not feel that I was being properly looked after, so I ran away. After I returned, I was removed from there and placed at Newfield. I believe that if I had been properly cared for and kept safe, I would not have run away, and I do not believe that I would have been hurt.
