- what life was like for you during this time
- how the people responsible for your care and welfare failed to carry out that duty (within or beyond your care setting)

Your statement for additional care settings

I remember 3 nurses coming in and grabbing me, taking me to what looked like a cupboard type room and they stuck something up my bum which felt like a hosepipe whilst being pinned down and this really did hurt. I also remember other nurses/doctors coming in and watching and at one stage I felt like there was an audience watching a medical experiment.

I never understood why this happened to me and I've suffered with nightmares since this.

This happened for around about an hour and it felt like torture. I struggle to understand who give permission for this as I was taken away from parents so I understand it wasn't them who give permission for this to happen.

This happened around 3/4 times in a week.
