I am just writing to you regarding the above patient's neuroimaging. This was performed in March 2024 and I cannot see a letter reporting the result to you. I apologise for that.

The images were reviewed at the time and did not show any significant findings but demonstrated wear and tear, which is expected, and that can predispose to neural irritation particularly at C5/C6 bilaterally and C6/C7 on the left. There is also a disc bulge at T10/T11 with slight impingement of the ventral surface of the cord. There is no clear correspondence with the right arm symptoms particularly localised at first and second finger.

There is no target for surgical intervention and conservative management is required as was discussed in my clinical letter.

Clinical Comments:

Many thanks for the referral of the above lady in regards to

I understand she takes folic acid. I see she had a borderline low Vitamin B12 at 241ng/L. **I must stress that for any neurological symptoms and sensory symptoms we would really like this level to be above 250ng/L and preferably above 300ng/L. Therefore I recommend oral supplementation.** She is a smoker and smokes one pack a day.

She reported having a sharp persisting pain around the cervicothoracic junction which lasted about three to four weeks in January followed by a numbness and pain in the right arm. Particularly evident symptoms are on the first and second finger.

I understand that she has lost 5kg but this occurred in a period of high stress and the weight loss has stabilised, not progressing further.

Neurological examination does reveal an abnormal sensory function to touch on the lateral side of the neck above the shoulder and the right arm without any thoracic dermatome level. Muscle strength is normal and full both proximally and distally at upper limbs and deep tendon reflexes are present and symmetric bilaterally. She does not have hard focal neurological signs and Hoffman sign is negative. Vibration sense is normal. Gait is normal.

She denied any symptoms on her bladder or on her legs.

I think it is worth arranging an MRI of cervical and thoracic spine to see if there has been any impingement. Given her functional status, I think most likely required measures will be conservative with physiotherapy for which she can self-refer in primary care. For symptom management, I would suggest either amitriptyline or gabapentin. Amitriptyline should be started at 10mg and increased weekly up to 50mg a day or at the lowest effective dose which does not cause side effects. As alternative, gabapentin could be started at 300mg on day 1, 300mg twice daily on day 2 and 300mg three times a day on day 3. She can then be increased to 400mg three times a day after a week. Either medication should be continued for three to four months at the suitable dose before being weaned off.

I will let you know the results of the MRI spine and I will arrange management appropriately if there are findings of relevance. Otherwise I am not arranging further neurology follow-up in this clinic.

NHS24 referral to MHAU citing low mood and suicidal ideation. Has been drinking alcohol overnight. Initially discussed over the phone however agreed to come to Stobhill MHAU for face-to-face assessment as was unable to agree to safety plan over the phone. Escorted to MHAU by son who remained in the car outside building during assessment.
Reason for attendance (<i>Description of individuals main concerns, their perceptions of difficulties and hopes from the service</i>)
Seen at Stobhill MHAU ta 11:50am by Kathleen Hutchison, Unscheduled Care Nurse, and Bernadette Glover, Senior Unscheduled Care Nurse. Reporting low mood in past few weeks which then hit crisis point last night when her daughter disclosed past childhood abuse perpetrated by Janice's mother – who also abused Janice in her childhood. Janice reports then experiencing suicidal thoughts with vague thoughts of "jumping from the nearest bridge" however no active plan or intent disclosed. Family are protective factors against acting on suicidal thoughts. Denies experiencing suicidal thoughts in the past. Helpseeking and future focussed. Janice refers to suicidal thoughts as means of "escape" and explains that she is overwhelmed with the responsibilities she has as a mum/wife and support system for her entire family. She explains that her family all turn to her for support and that Janice is very much viewed as the "rock" of the family. Janice stated she is an "alcoholic" and is keen for support with her alcohol misuse. She has been misusing alcohol for 10+ years and mainly consumes lager and sometimes vodka. Has had one period of sobriety which lasted 11 days and ended in past 24 hours when Janice was invited to her daughters for "a drink" and consumed 1+ bottle of vodka. She began drinking at 5 or 6pm and stopped drinking at approximately 9am – a short while prior to calling NHS24 and engaging with MHAU. Janice has significant caring responsibility for her husband who is living with a brain injury for the past few years following a case of encephalitis. Janice reports feeling guilt over her husbands' disability and she explains that she "thought he was tired" for a few days and feels she failed to spot that he was seriously unwell. She reports that he has memory issues and that he require help with personal care. Janice does not with for support with this and is keen to continue to provide this support for her husband herself. Janice reports a turbulent upbringing in which she had involvement with social services and was looked after in care services due to physical and emotional abuse perpetrated by Janice's mother and also sexual abuse perpetrated by Janice's brother. Janice has not seen her mother since her sisters funeral in 2011 and describes her mother as "evil".
Psychiatric history (<i>previous/ongoing mental health problems, diagnoses and interventions, via GP or mental health services, and their impact; h/o self harm/attempted suicide; previous admission/detentions</i>)
No history of involvement with mental health services. Self reports 10 year history of alcohol misuse with no involvement with ADRS. Self reports previous overdose 20+ years ago. Family history of mental illness – sister completed suicide 10 years ago and was reportedly diagnosed with paranoid schizophrenia. Sister reportedly had several inpatient admissions to Stobhill and was on anti-psychotic medications.

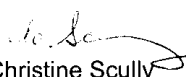

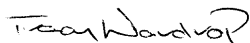
Thank you for referring the above named lady to the Community Mental Health Team. I assessed her on the 21st June 2005 at the 3-Towns Resource Centre.

I would be grateful for your input in this patient. I am not very sure exactly which department to refer her. Basically she is a new patient on our list complaining of a one year history of depression since the birth of her last child in 1999. Since then she had one miscarriage and a sterilisation.

At present she is on anti-depressants from her previous doctor and although I do not have the notes she tells me that she was also referred to the Community Psychiatric Services.

Janice does have symptoms of depression with sleep disturbance, being in a low mood, irritability and poor concentration. She just picks at food but she has not lost any weight. She does not find anything which makes her happy.

She had been commenced on Edronax 400mg bd and we have discontinued with this prescription.

When I saw her for a second consultation she opened out a little more to me and told me of the history of sexual abuse by her brother.

12th October, 2000.

This occurred for two years from the age of 11 to 12. It is interesting to note that six months ago he was tried for rape and has been in prison for six years. This was apparently front page news and not surprisingly has rekindled all Janice's anxieties and fears. She tells me that she is very much alone in that she had told of the incest to her mother, but her mother had never believed her and consequently she does not meet her mother now. She has never seen her father.

Janice does have three children and sometimes she finds them a handful. She has husband but describes him as a bit of a "pain". She does admit to their being some good things in her life in that she has her children. She does indicate that she would like to better both herself and her situation. She said she would have liked to have talked to someone about her experiences.

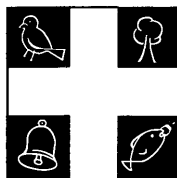

I would like to refer the above named woman to your service. She was referred to us by GP Dr Adams-Strump.

This lady has history of post-natal depression and since the birth of her fourth child reports feeling irritable and lacking in volition.

During interview it became clear that when confronted with challenging situations Mrs Nicholl becomes very aggressive both verbally and physically. This is along standing problem. At the age of fifteen she was charged with attempted murder. At present she is due in court charged with threatening a minor. There appear to have been other incidences throughout the years which have not had police involvement.

Mrs Nicholl was sexually abused by her brother when aged 11. This resulted in her being placed in a children's home. Due to a tendency to start fires she was frequently moved.

At present her brother is facing a rape charge and this appears to be the main stressor. She constantly ruminates about the outcome of the court case.

Although Mrs Nicholl was referred to our service with suspected low mood (for which the GP prescribed Reboxetine) this does not appear to be the main issue.

I would be grateful of your assessment.
