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REPORT

1. Evidence of facts relating to Complaint.

In the interview the lady was quoted by the mother with "I am in I have been saying up you". It appears that Mr. Simpson from the Missing Dept. had visited the mother that on a visit to the home he had found the children unattended. Mother stated that the children are never left in the home alone, that when Mr. Simpson called at the home she was at the nearby shops. I referred to the incident of the home on October, 1961 when the Police had myself were involved when the children were unattended and an older woman's child ended up in hospital with a fractured skull. Mother was strongly advised that the most serious worry was to the children.

- With regard to the Missing Official being at the home, it appears that a meeting was held with the Police, against the family, mainly in relation to the children's behaviour.

During the visit I established that Miss Page, S. 1, is involved with the family, the child Stewart having appeared at a Children's Hearing through non-attendance at school.

I advised the mother of her responsibilities.

On a later visit Miss Page informed that Stewart was made the subject of Sect 44 (1) (a) on 19. 7.62 at a Children's Hearing for non-attendance at school and alleged offences. Miss Page stated that Stewart is also involved with the "A.C.S. project.
