Dear Mr. Fraser,

Your son Stewart has been referred to me by Tayside Police regarding the alleged theft of a bicycle on 25th October last year. The Police report that he was cautioned and charged for the alleged matter on Sunday, 17th January this year at your home. The report reached me on 2nd February 1982.

Stewart was placed on supervision regarding other matters by a Children's Hearing on 17th December 1981. Because he is now under supervision and because of the unsatisfactory nature of the formal evidence in this case as it affects your son, I have decided not to refer this alleged offence to a Children's Hearing. You will accordingly hear no more about it unless your son is cited as a witness in relation to the other boy involved.

Dear Mrs Fraser,

Your sons William and Stewart have been referred to me by Tayside Police who allege that on 3rd July 1982 they were found sniffing glue in a shelter in St Clement's School grounds. Both boys had plastic bags containing glue in their possession and an empty Evo-Stik container was found nearby.

In relation to Stewart I think that this was the incident discussed at his recent Hearing and was in fact taken into consideration when the decision to vary his supervision requirement to name Burnside House as his place of residence was made. Accordingly I will be taking no further formal action with regard to it.

I am somewhat concerned at William's involvement in sniffing glue since this is not the first time if my information is correct. You may remember that about a year ago you yourself contacted the police regarding him having been assaulted and it transpired that he had been sniffing glue when the assault took place. Indeed it seems that he was still under the influence of glue when he was interviewed by the police.

However, since Mrs Caplan is already visiting you in relation to Stewart, I have decided to allow you to consult her on a voluntary basis regarding any worries you may have about William. Although you are under no obligation to do this I would hope that you would accept any advice Mrs Caplan may offer since the object of the exercise is to keep Billy out of more serious trouble in future.

I sincerely hope I will not hear of him again.

Your son Stewart has been referred to me by Tayside Police who allege that on 7th September 1982, along with one other he committed a Breach of the Peace in Harestone Road, Dundee, by shouting and swearing. Apparently he had absconded from Burnside House at the time, dressed only in pyjamas. He was later apprehended by police in Harestone Road having been sniffing glue and staggering over the road causing motorists to swerve. Unfortunately his choice of language when he was approached by the police left a lot to be desired.

You may remember that in my last letter to you in relation to a similar offence I intimated I would be taking no formal action because of the trial period with Stewart staying at home and attending Balgovan School on a day basis. I have spoken to Mrs Caplan about this and I have been informed that he has done very well over the past few weeks. So well in fact that a review may be called to vary Stewart's supervision requirement which at present names Burnside as his official place of residence. In view of his good progress and since the offence seems to have occurred before the trial was put into operation I am prepared once again to take no formal action and accordingly you will hear no more about the incident from me.
