Dear Mrs Fraser,

Your son Stewart has been referred to me by Tayside Police who allege that between 7th and 10th January 1983, along with two others he broke into two portacabins in Gourdie Industrial Estate and stole a large quantity of tools. I have also received the police report concerning the occasion when he broke into your house and stole money. You may remember that this was mentioned at the Hearing on 22nd March 1983, when Stewart was placed in Colonsay House, Perth.

In view of the fact that both these incidents occurred before this Hearing I propose to take no further action in relation to them. I am sure that the outcome would not have been any different even if these offences could have been officially considered. Accordingly you will hear no more about them from me.

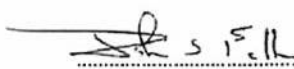

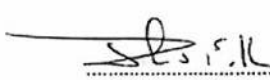

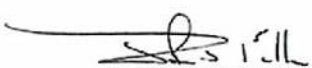
