Thank you for asking me to see this lady.

Diagnosis: Mechanical low back pain

History: This lady, who has had back pain for several years, complains of back pain in the thoracic spine radiating into her lower back. She also complains of pain going down her left leg as far as the mid-thigh. There are no pins and needles. She has had some numbness in her left hand first thing in the morning. She states that her back is stiff all the time and worse first thing in the morning, which can last for about an hour. She denies any problems with any other joints. She tells me that she has had painkillers and the back pain has been getting worse since her last pregnancy. Her baby is about 3 months old now.

Clinically: She stands straight, generalised tenderness over the thoraco-lumbar spine, movements are restricted in all directions and SLR is 70° bilaterally causing low back pain. Nerve root tension signs are negative and neurologically she is intact.

Plan: To first of all arrange for some physiotherapy and reassess her after the course of physio. I have also given her a course of anti-inflammatories and if they do indeed suit her, then she might come to you for a repeat prescription. I do not feel that she actually has any nerve root compromise, hence I have not asked for any investigations in the form of MRI as yet.

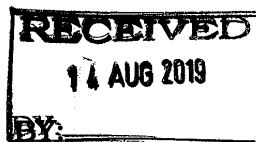

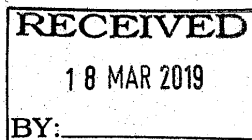
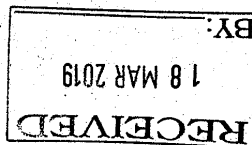

Thank you for referring the above mentioned patient to me,

Presenting Complaint:

39 years. P2 - NVD. C/O: Incidental finding of possible dermoid cyst in right ovary (during scan, miscarriage) - No pain or bleeding - No contraception - not needed as not sexually active. NKDA. Smears up to date and normal. No medical or surgical significant history.

Clinical Findings:

Abdominal examination - Soft lax, non-tender, no mass or cyst.

Investigations and tests:

US Pelvis: Poor visualisation transabdominally, due to the poorly filled bladder. Anteverted uterus. The endometrium appears ill-defined, where measured it has an endometrial thickness of 7 mm, towards the fundus. No evidence of an intrauterine pregnancy seen. The endometrium appears to demonstrate a couple of small subcentimetre cystic spaces (largest demonstrated measures 3 mm in diameter) - ?nature of cystic spaces. 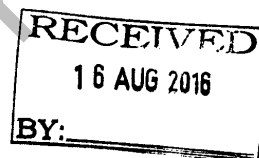

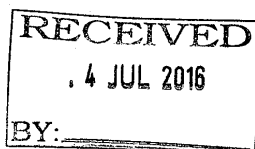
