Andrew and his mother were invited to attend the review, and did not do so.

Summary of Discussion + Goals/Tasks for the Future (Goals to be listed separately)

Recommendations: from the previous review on 22.4.85

1. Practical guidance and support were provided by Robert Smith, Special Case Officer, D.H.S.S. and he has arranged for the Careers Officer to see Andrew. Andrew was on a Y.T.S. and it is believed he gave it up because of transport difficulties. Mr. Smith was also asked to encourage Andrew to call to see the social worker, Mrs. Smith, and Andrew has not done so.
2. [REDACTED] left the home prior to the involvement with the family of the present social worker.
3. The previous social worker gave Andrew support at the time when Sarah returned to care.

Information

The case was transferred to the present social worker, Mrs. J. Smith, on 3.2.86, and did not include a transfer summary on Andrew. Mrs. Smith first made contact with the family on 18.2.86 when she visited the home and met Miss Mill and Andrew. Mrs. Smith has seen Andrew on only one occasion since that time, despite repeated attempts to arrange appointments with him.

The records on Andrew and Sarah are confusing, because so many of the entries refer to matters which include the both of them.

Recommendations

1. The social worker to request a review of the supervision requirement informing the Reporter that there has been little contact with Andrew, and he does not appear to want to co-operate with the social worker.
2. A recorded delivery letter to be sent to Andrew offering him an appointment at the Kirkton Office. This appointment will be arranged to inform Andrew that a request will be made to the Reporter for a review of the Supervision Requirement.

3. If the Children's Panel decide to discharge the supervision requirement, an out-of-care meeting will be arranged to decide if the Rescinding of Parental Rights should be sought.
