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08.10.97 Home visit to William, Mr and Mrs [REDACTED]	William says that his dad and his brother went to his school at lunchtime, took William out of school and bought him a "lucky bag"; that this was at Longhaugh and was "a long time ago". Took William to visit Camperdown Park Wildlife Centre, and to see where [REDACTED] is living. William was well behaved. William said he is happy and spoke warmly of the [REDACTED] noting he is enjoying having his sister staying with them (on respite).
