Thank you for seeing Mrs Margery who I have seen in the pain clinic today. This lady has developed refractory trigeminal neuralgic pain in the right V2 mandibular distribution since the post dental extraction. She complains of sudden onset burning lancinating pain which has been progressively worse with acute exacerbations. She has tried neuropathic medication and has also seen a neurologist.

Anything can trigger the pain. She has also been to A&E on a couple of occasions.

On examination the cranial nerves are unremarkable and there is allodynia in the right V2 distribution. The rest of the neurology was normal.
