Clinical Summary: 57 yrs old lady with a h/o big toe nails removal on 19/6/24 because of ingrown and fungal infection. 2 days afterward she noticed discharge from her nail beds and the toes were also inflamed. According to patient, She was seen by the podiatry team and by the doctors in Minister hospital and treated with Antibiotics for the toe infection. Patient also had mechanical fall after catching her toe on the floor and tripping over and she fell on her left side. She has small superficial wound on the left ankle (healing now). She also has a h/o left sided chest pain and CXR was done at Minister hospital and they discharged her with Doxycycline and Prednisolone course.

She noticed a rash in between her thigh for 10 days, which has progressively got worse - spreading to her abdomen, buttocks and legs. She also mentioned that her feet bilaterally since the 21/6/24 has become red, swollen, tender and warm to touch. Patient reports within the last 10 days as well her elbow, wrists and knuckles were also swollen and tender. She has been finding it difficult to weight bear as it is very painful for her.

Rheumatology reviewed the patient and vasculitis screenings have been requested(Still pending). Patient also referred to Dermatology team for the rash(no reply from them yet).

She also developed AKI- most likely NSAID induced (?Interstitial Nephritis). She has been managed with IV fluids. Her AKI improved from AKI 2 to AKI 1. We have encourage Katrina to stay hydrated with clear fluids.

As of discharge patient is clinically stable.

She will be reviewed in SDEC on 5.8.2024 for chase of vasculitic screen, wound culture, symptom review and rheumatology review if needed.
