.She was admitted via SDEC on the 22/7/21 with worsening SOB, chest pain and longstanding back pain. Since being on admission, her bloods have been unremarkable and CXR clear.

Due to the chronic back pain, she had an MRI spine which was unremarkable.

Further more, she was seen by the Respiratory nurse who recommended SMART nebs wean , Fostair 100/6 tice daily via spacer, Incruse Ellipta 55 mcg once weaned off ipratropium. PEFR dairy in 2 weeks (7am and 7pm) , OP spirometry with reversibility when well, chest clinic follow up by Paramothayan.

She has improved clinically and now stable for discharge on SMART wean
