Dear Colleague,

Thank you for seeing this 53 year old lady who has recently had her annual asthma review with the nurse. During the telephone consultation, she reported that she has had a chronic cough for 6 months with worsening SOB on exertion, associated with a wheeze also. She reports chest pain when coughing with the cough sometimes productive of clear sputum. The

nurse reports that she sounded SOB on the phone but was still able to speak in full sentences. She has been seen by OOH in April who issued abx and steroids and suggested spirometry. She is currently taking fostair x2 puffs QDS and using salbutamol 8 times daily which she reports neither is improving her symptoms. She is currently vaping and recently gave up smoking after 25 years.

Bloods and chest x-ray have already been requested and these will be reviewed with her when the results are received.

I would therefore be grateful if you could kindly see this lady as a matter of urgency for your further review and management.
