Redress Comments:

Patient walked into the MIU unaccompanied and with a normal gait and no other issues walking. Patient states she feels systemically well in herself today. Upon examination, there is good epithelialisation of wound edges with approximately 40% granulation and 60% stubborn slough visible. No malodour from the wound noted; and high sloughy exudate uptake on the old dressing when it was removed. No sign of deformity, swelling, bruising, heat, erythema, active bleeding or infection present at this time. Wound irrigated with Prontosan to clean and Aquacell Ag applied as a primary dressing to promote moist wound healing, help prevent infection and reduce bacterial load. Covered with sterile gauze pad to uptake exudate and secured with Duoderm dressing. Aquacell Ag may now be used as a primary dressing for a further 8 days. Patient to return to MIU in 3 days time for a review of her wound and redressing.
