Redress Comments:

Patient walked into the MIU unaccompanied and with a normal gait and no other issues walking. Patient states she feels systemically well in herself today. Upon examination, there is good epithilisation of wound edges with approximately 40% granulation and 60% stubborn slough visible. Some slight malodour from the wound noted; and high sloughy exudate uptake on the old dressing when it was removed. Small area of stubborn slough was able to be lifted from the wound bed with the aid of forceps today. No sign of deformity, swelling, bruising, heat, erythema, active bleeding or infection present at this time. Wound irrigated with Prontosan to clean and Aquacell Ag applied as a primary dressing to promote moist wound healing, help prevent infection and reduce bacterial load. Covered with sterile gauze pad to uptake exudate and secured with Duoderm dressing. Having checked back on previous notes, Aquacell Ag was applied at the last dressing, prior to this Aquacell was applied. Therefore Aquacell Ag may now be used as a primary dressing for a further 10 days. Patient to return to MIU in 3 days time for a review of her wound and redressing.
