Redress Comments:

Patient walked into the MIU unaccompanied, with a normal gait and with a slight limp, otherwise walking with no issues. Patient states she feels systemically well in herself today. Upon examination, the wound continues to epithilise and granulation is evident 70% with slough 30%. There is still redness to the surrounding skin however it is less than the previous visit. The wound still appears to have some infection present as there is a slight malodour present. The patient states she is continuing to take the Flucloxacillin prescribed by her GP as directed. Patient states she took Oramorph this morning at 08.00 and can tolerate the wound dressing change with no problem. There is no sign of deformity, swelling, heat or active bleeding present. Wound irrigated with Prontosan to clean, Aquacel Ag applied as a primary dressing to the wound bed to promote moist wound healing, help reduce infection and reduce bacterial load, covered with sterile gauze to uptake exudate, secured with Duoderm to help deslough wound. Patient to return to the MIU either next Monday afternoon or Tuesday morning. Advised patient to return to the MIU sooner if any concerns.

Duoderm (Single Use), Gauze (Single Use), Aquacel AG (Single Use), Cleaned with Prontosan
