Peter then asked writer if he could get a lift to his [REDACTED] to which this was granted as it would give the writer a chance to talk to Peter and to counsel him on the dangers of taking illegal substances. When writer told Peter he would like to meet his [REDACTED] Peter became very agitated so given Peter's present state of mind writer thought best not to pursue this issue. Peter was informed that writer will do another outreach on Thursday 13th April and for Peter to be in a more positive frame of mind to which Peter agreed that he would try.
