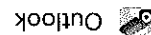

Description: Patient requesting injectable GLP-1 agonist
Comment: Dear DSN
This man with T2DM currently is not on treatment - commenced SGLT2 due to concerns about possible heart failure in past but now stopped due to side effects of balanitis and recurrent thrush. He declines metformin due to family member with significant side effects. Currently HbA1c is 60 and weight is 110kg with BMI of 38.5. He is symptomatic of diabetes just now and would be keen for treatment to help him lose weight in addition. Grateful if he could be seen to be initiated on GLP-1 agonist.

As this patient is symptomatic and not currently prescribed oral glucose lowering therapy, it would be advisable to initiate Glucalide, which should alleviate discomfort and improve glycaemic control.
Please titrate Glucalide as necessary and exclude other causes of symptoms. Most patients would be asymptomatic at 60 mmol/mol presenting with CBG levels < 10 mmol/L
Glycaemic target for this patient may be 53 - 64 depending on frailty scoring as less stringent control is recommended when > 65 years.

Current Medication:

Amlopidine 5mg od, Aspirin 75mg od, Ceftriaxone, Empagliflozin 10mg od, Omeprazole, Salbutamol inhaler, Trelegy Ellipra inhaler, and numerous acute prescriptions including Doxycycline and Prednisolone (20/10/25), Bumetanide (July & Sept 2025) (no longer taking Bumetanide), Ramipril (7/7/25 & 15/7/25) (note AKI 14/7/25)

Medication Changes:

None at present, can continue Amlodipine as patient says has not changed ankle swelling and has really helped hypertension control.

Follow Up:

Discharged with worsening advice I saw this 69 year old in clinic. He was accompanied by his wife Nicola. He was referred via the heart failure diagnostic pathway. He describes exertional breathlessness on minimal exertion but this has improved when his hypertension (systolic blood pressure was over 200 mmHg) has improved with Amlodipine which has also not changed in his ankle oedema. He has had ankle oedema to the lower calf for 10 years which has improved when he has had compression stocking from the lymphoedema clinic. Bumetanide helped as well but he is no longer taking this. He denies orthopnoea and says he sleeps with two pillows. Inhalers for COPD has helped his breathing too. On direct questioning he says he has never had any chest pain, chest heaviness, chest pressure or chest tightness although I note this was noted in the earlier referral letter. He has no cough or

On ECGs there is possible inferior Q waves which were seen in August 2024 too. However the echo does not mention any inferior wall motion abnormality. He is already on Aspirin and is intolerant of statins.

On examination lung fields clear. Leg oedema to lower calf. BP 141/110 but at home he says blood pressure readings range from 123/89 to 135/90. Pulse 81 BPM.

His diet is said to be good and his wife helps with his diet. He has cut out snacks and has reduced portion sizes and this has helped with intentional weight loss.

I reassured him that his echo does not show any features of heart failure. I suspect his COPD and obesity is contributing to his symptoms mostly. Chest x-ray in July 2025 reported as no evidence of cardiac failure, no pleural effusions, normal heart and mediastinal contour and the lungs are clear.

I mentioned the main recommendations would be to achieve good control of his blood pressure, type 2 diabetes and body weight to reduce the risk of cardiovascular disease. I gave advice if there was

Thank you for referring the above gentleman who presented with bilateral lower leg swelling which started to develop around 10 years ago, and which has gradually worsened. As you are aware past medical history includes psoriasis, spinal stenosis and hypertension. He has chronic back and neck pain due to spinal compression following an RTA in the 1980's where he broke both legs and his pelvis. He also suffers from type 2 diabetes, renal insufficiency and he is currently undergoing cardiac investigations.

On examination mild oedema was present in both lower legs and feet. Pulses were palpable in both feet, capillary refill was satisfactory and the skin was intact and in good condition, with no signs of infection present.

Mr Keown has chronic lymphoedema which although initially due to trauma from his RTA, has certainly been exacerbated by his reduced mobility and a possible episode of cellulitis in his right leg. The importance of good skin care, keeping mobile and maintaining a healthy weight in the management of his oedema was discussed. Class 1 stockings have been ordered for support and he will report on these when they arrive. No planned follow up has been arranged, but Mr Keown was encouraged to contact the Lymphoedema Clinic at any time to arrange a review if required.
