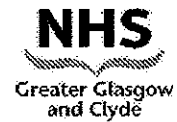

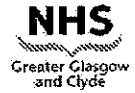

At L4/L5 there was a disc bulge causing minor contact of the exiting right L4 nerve root and L5/S1 showed minor contact of the disc with the exiting left L5 nerve root.
