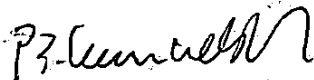

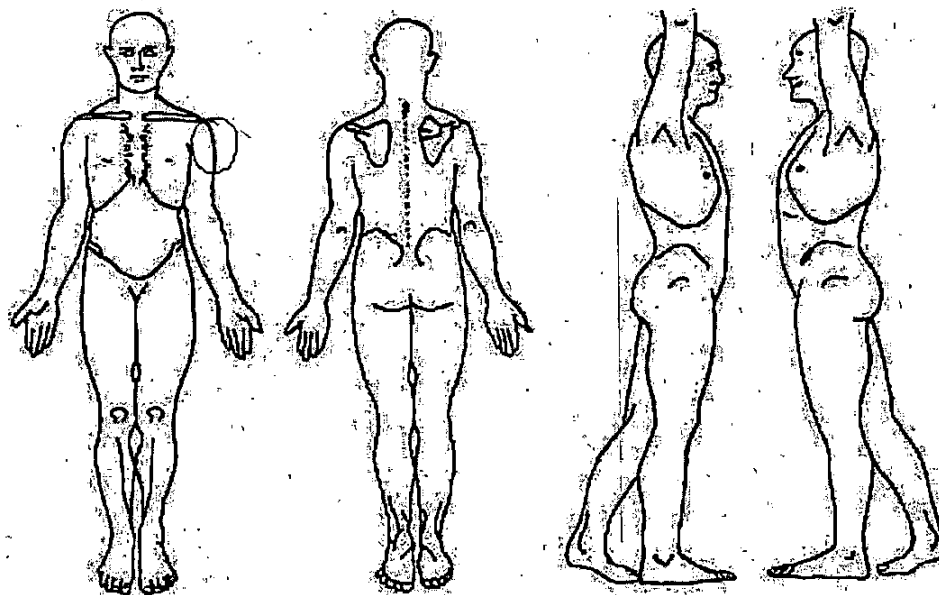

It was a pleasure to meet Mr Craddock who came to the clinic today accompanied by his wife. He has a background history of type II diabetes, hypertension, asthma and a previous prostate cancer, diverticulosis and coeliac disease. The reason for the clinic today is for management of the gallstone cholecystitis. Previously he attended to the ward 4C clinic in July 2025 due to sudden onset of epigastric pain radiating to the right side and associated with vomiting. In July the surgical team organised an ultrasound scan and this showed a thick walled gallbladder which contains multiple stones. He has a BMI of 40.52 and today we measured his weight again and it is 115kgs. He also complained that he the same right upper quadrant pain during this week which is colicky in nature. Today I have explained to Mr Craddock that he has symptomatic gallstones which need laparoscopic cholecystectomy. On the other hand he has a high BI which is 40.52 and I have explained to him that ideally for the operation his BMI should be <35. Due to the symptomatic gallstones I have discussed this issue with Mr Manda and we have decided to review him again in six months with regards weight loss. Mr Craddock is aware that he needs to reduce his weight as BMI of >35 is associated with increased risk of post-operative complications as well. I have given the patient an EIDO information leaflet and he is aware that he needs to contact Mr Manda's secretary if he has any queries. Hopefully Mr Craddock can reduce his weight during this six month period and is also aware that he may need to come to the hospital if the cholecystitis flared up.

This 69 year old gentleman was referred by his GP with right upper quadrant pain. He described feeling feverish at home. On examination two days prior he had right upper quadrant pain with mildly raised inflammatory markers, white cell 10, CRP 15. He had an ultrasound which demonstrated a thick-walled gallbladder containing numerous gallstones in keeping with cholecystitis. Patient was well enough for oral antibiotics and discharged home with plans to return today for review.

Today on review patient described resolved pain. Certainly on examination abdomen was soft and markedly less tender than on Monday. Bloods repeated were normal.

Patient currently has a BMI of 40. Background of type II diabetes, hypertension and asthma. I have discussed with him and his partner that it seems conservative management is settling his cholecystitis. In terms of removing his gallbladder at a later date, I have discussed with him the need for weight loss prior to consideration of elective surgery. I have arranged he come to Mr Manda's clinic in a few months time to see how he is getting on and potentially discuss laparoscopic cholecystectomy if symptoms persist and he has managed to lose some weight.

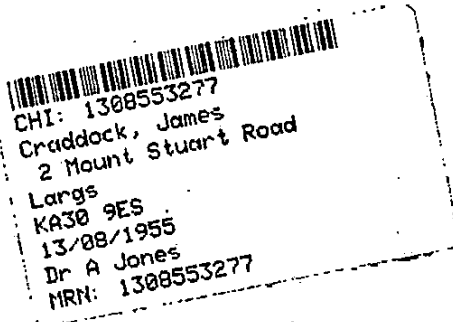

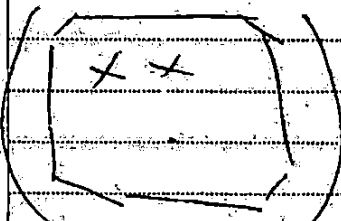
