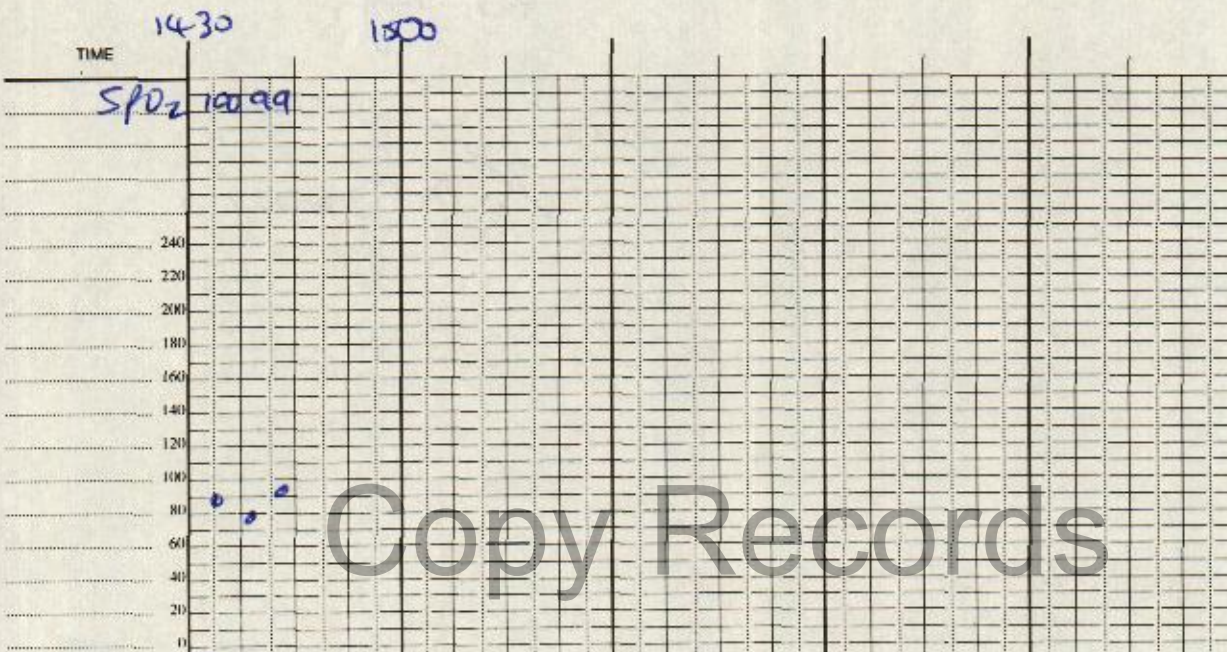

She seemed however quite a nice girl and appears to be under a bit of pressure from her boyfriend's family to have termination of pregnancy carried out. Ultrasound showed her to have a pregnancy of only 6 - 7 weeks, fetal heart was seen. I managed to have a talk to her on her own without her boyfriend's stepfather who was there and I think she has some serious doubts about whether she should have termination carried out. I explained to her that it had to be her decision but overall, with the difficulties that she has it was going to be extremely difficult to contemplate bringing up a baby. I have given her a date therefore for the 9th November to come in for a termination of pregnancy and this will give her a couple of weeks to consider things and discuss her feelings with her boyfriend's family. She herself of course has really no family to help. Overall I guess she will probably come to the decision that termination of pregnancy is the right thing for her and will probably come in on the date. If she changes her mind she has promised to let us know.

As you are aware, I have been meeting with Fiona together with her foster-mother Carol on a regular basis since June 1994. The focus of these meetings has been to address Fiona's experience of being the victim of sexual abuse.

Good progress has been made. Fiona continues to maintain the abuse was not her fault and no longer has 'flashbacks' to abusive incidents. In addition, she has stated 'I know I am safe where I am living now'.

Of more concern recently has been her attitude towards Carol and her jealousy towards her fellow foster-child, Andrew. Carol feels Fiona's behaviour is largely a reflection of her age and neediness for attention.
