Tried brufen gel on minor ailments but didn't find it helped along w/ht co-codamol tabs. Not keen to take oral NSAIDs, has had reaction to brufen tabs before, so requests alternative gel. Advice re heat as well.

2) ?uti. Urinary frequency ++ but really nil else of note. Send MSSU in first instance.

29/06/2016 Shoulder pain L side: uncomfortable since carrying a bible on march 3d ago, nil to find O/E, tender anteriorly only, FRoM shoulder & neck. Taking co-codamol 8/500 to no avail. Px issued & advised re gentle movement & no heavy lifting. Asking for diaz- no.

Is thriving in new job- running pub for friend. Dr John Canning

31/05/2016 Telephone encounter - wanting a sick line as her dog has died.. NO!! Very insistent that she wants a line for 2 weeks before she starts work in her friends pub. Having "trouble" with the job centre. NO Dr Rosemary Tierney

19/04/2016 Patient reviewed Looking for diazepam, piriton (which she uses for insomnia and goes through 600mls a month), co-codamol 30/500 and a line. See previous note from MG about this - very difficult to justify signing her off when again today, she reiterated that she "couldn't handle the job centre just now".

taking a 2mg diazepam daily--stop this today and for no more

taking co-codamol 30/500 for a "bubble" feeling in her back. Advised that these are highly addictive and that we should reduce the strength back down to 8/500. She is in agreement with this.

using 600mls of piriton a month as a sleeping aid. script given today (generic only), but we need to look at changing/stopping this.

Given one last 4 week line and told that this will not be extended past 17/5/16/. FOR NO FURTHER LINES. Dr Rosemary Tierney

24/03/2016 C/O - panic attack Ongoing issues, wanting signed off for 6 weeks, largely just because she cant be bothered with job center. Tells me her ex/partner has been camping outside her house and has broken into a neighbours pub, "to get at her". Advised if no evidence to support this unlikely to ture or intentional. Needs to not worry about this and get on with life. Advised I will give her a 4 weeks MED3 for panic attacks and dont want to be doing these for months and months as I feel reasons are pretty vague here.
