**Summary of Assessment:**

Sharon is a 30 year old lady who is finding it hard to cope after having to give up her market stall in Stranraer two years ago. This was mainly due to problems with her 12 year old son Hayden whom she says was proving to be difficult at school and had to be excluded on several occasions. According to Sharon, Hayden would hit her and tell her what to do. Recently Child Care Services became involved and Hayden has temporarily been placed in foster care. Child Care Services are currently investigating to see if Sharon is fit enough to look after her other daughter Angel aged 7, due to alleged abuses of taking alcohol. No evidence of a psychiatric disorder, but due to Sharon's current stressors she is experiencing symptoms of anxiety and agoraphobia.

Agreed Intervention:

Following discussion at the team meeting on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2004 it was decided to refer this lady for anxiety management which is now being carried out by NSF at the Phoenix Club in Stranraer. She will be sent an appointment in the near future.

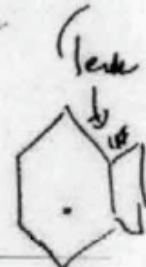
