

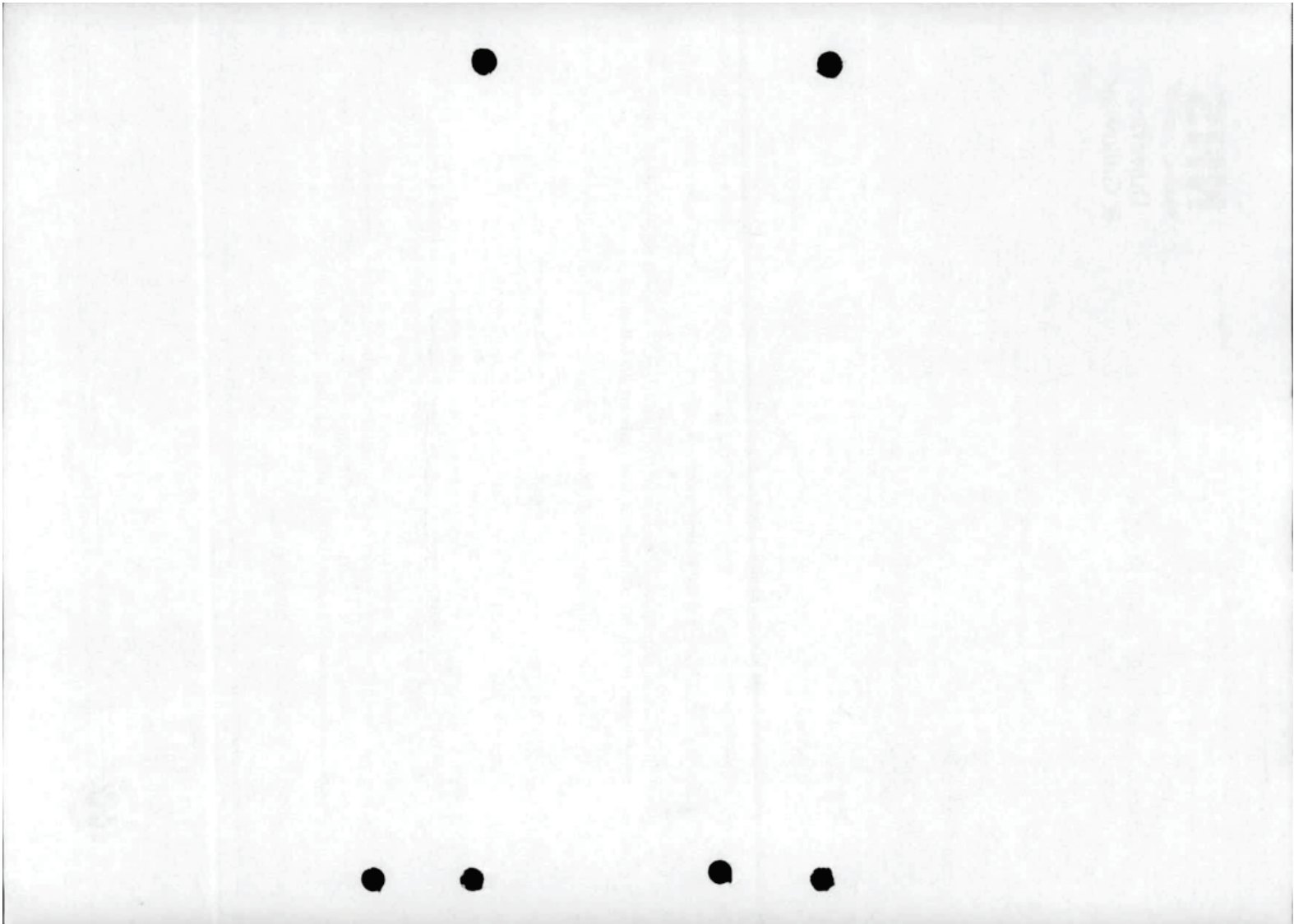

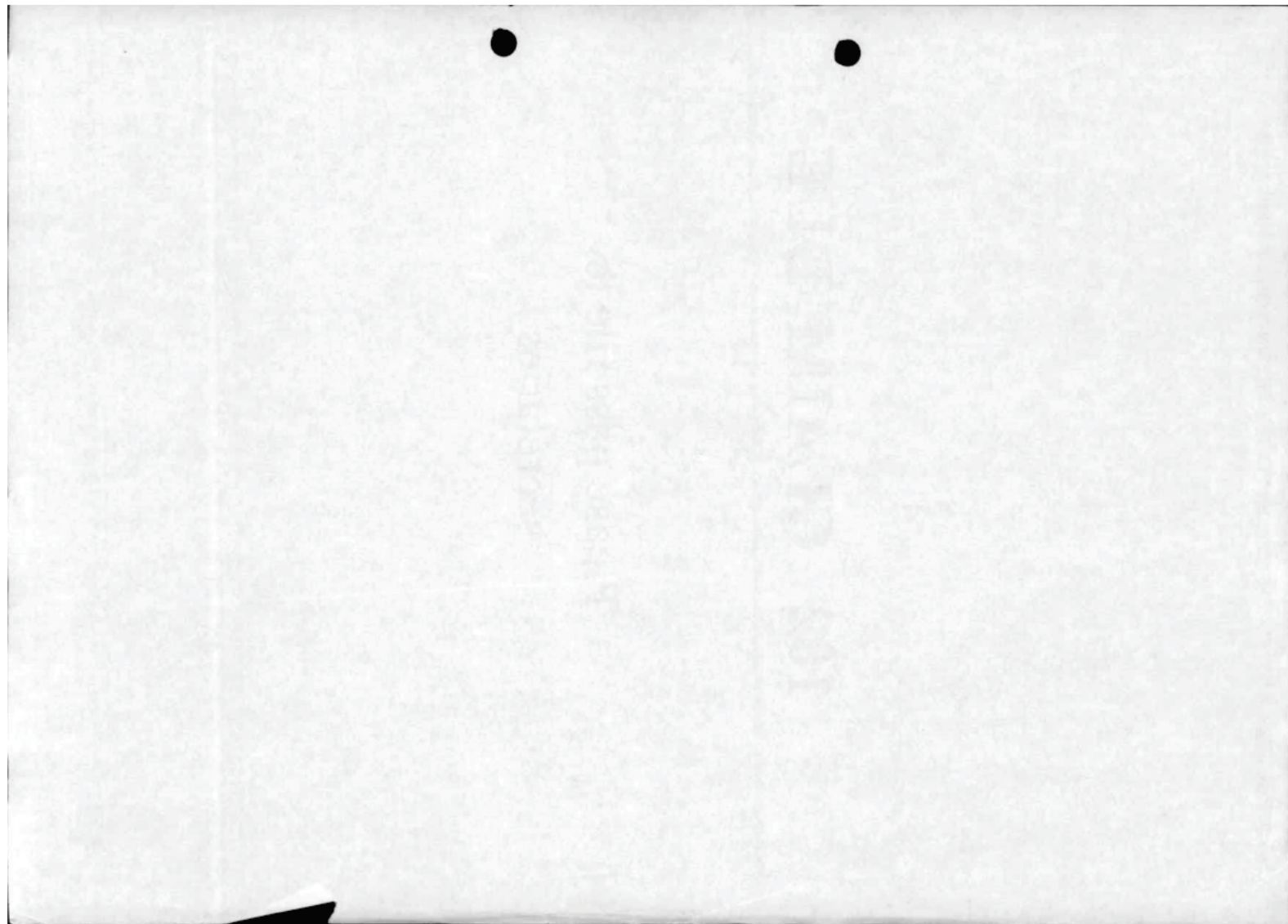

This letter is to confirm that over the last few months Sharon's life has been somewhat stressful.

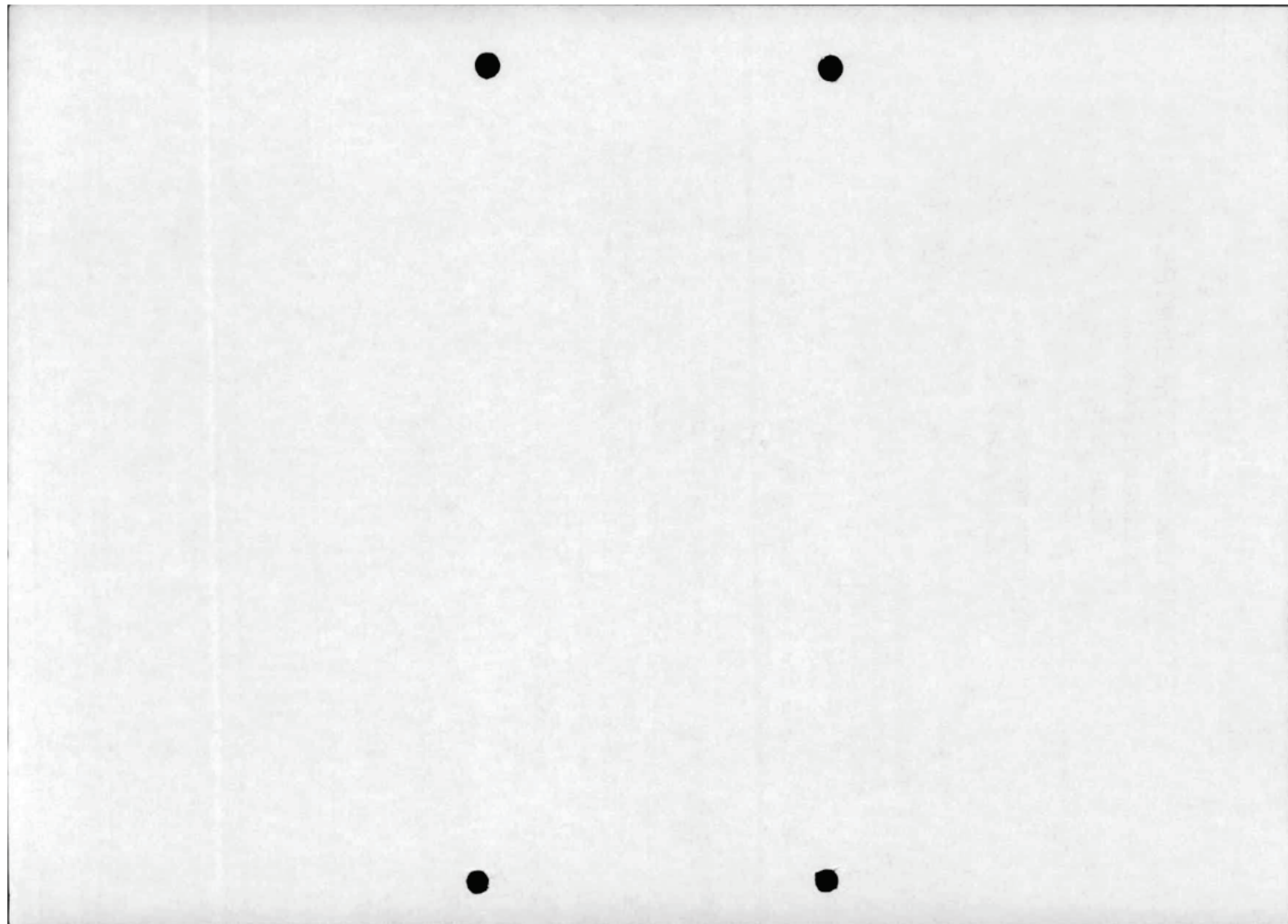
She has had significant problems with behaviour of her son as well as several episodes of very severe gastritis.

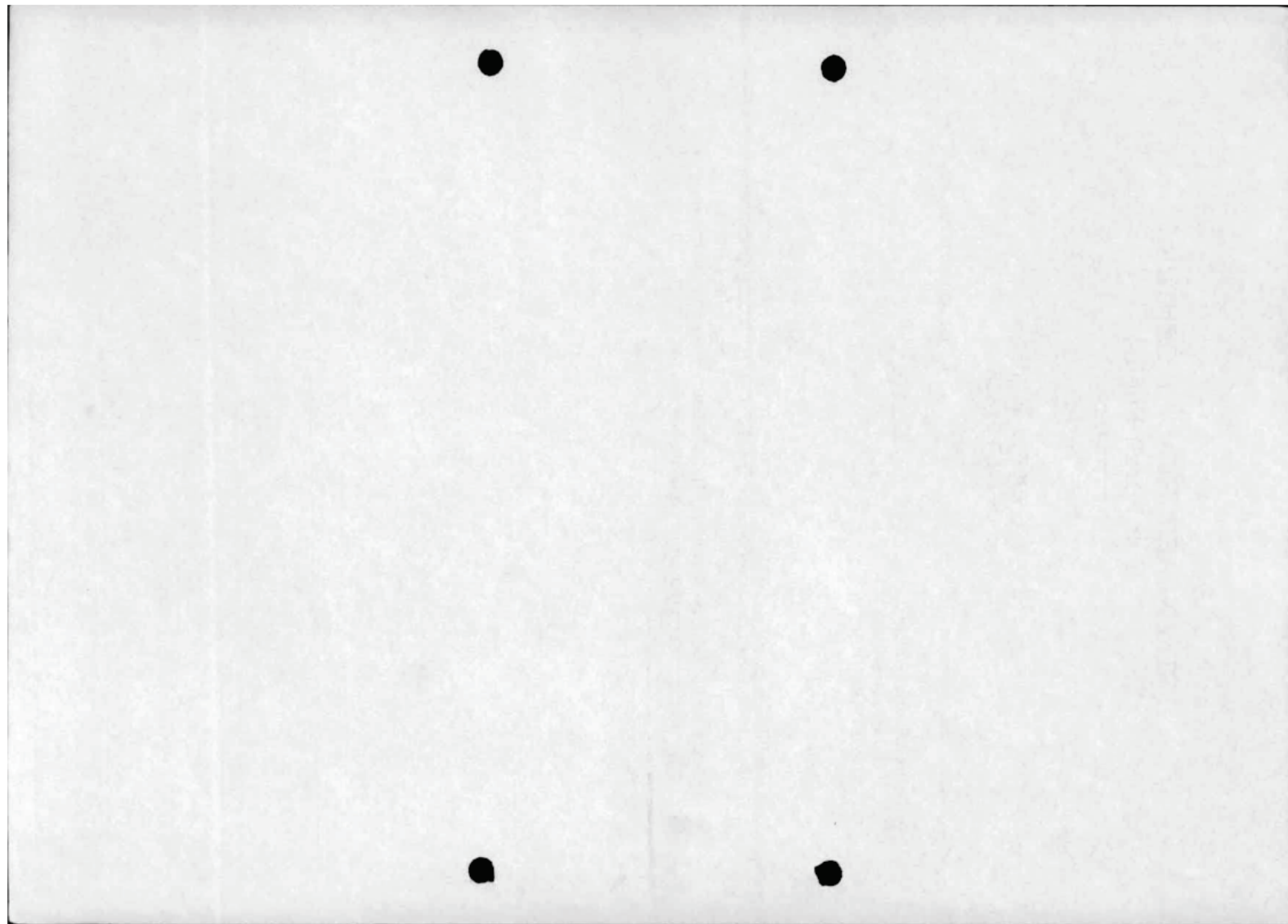

Re Sharon Holmes, 2 Old Port Avenue, Stranraer.

Thank you for referring this lady to the surgical clinic. Sharon recently noticed a painless lump in the upper aspect of her left breast which tends to come and go. At the clinic today the lump had completely disappeared. She does not suffer from cyclical mastalgia and she has had no previous breast disease. I note however that her mother died of breast cancer at the age of 42 years and her maternal grandmother also had breast cancer. She has three aunts on her mother's side but she has lost touch with them and does not know if any of them developed breast cancer. Similarly she does not know the fate of her cousins.

On examination there was some nodularity in the upper aspect of the left breast but I could not feel a focal lesion today in either breast and both axillae felt normal. I suspect Sharon has a benign lump which fluctuates with her menstrual cycle and I think the best plan would be to see her again in six weeks time at a different point of her cycle to see if the lump has reappeared. From the family history point of view I think she should be examined at our clinic on an annual basis and when she reaches her early thirties I think she should have mammography every two years.

On examination she has a small lump on the left breast and indeed I felt one on the right breast. This is mobile and feels like fibrocystic disease to me.

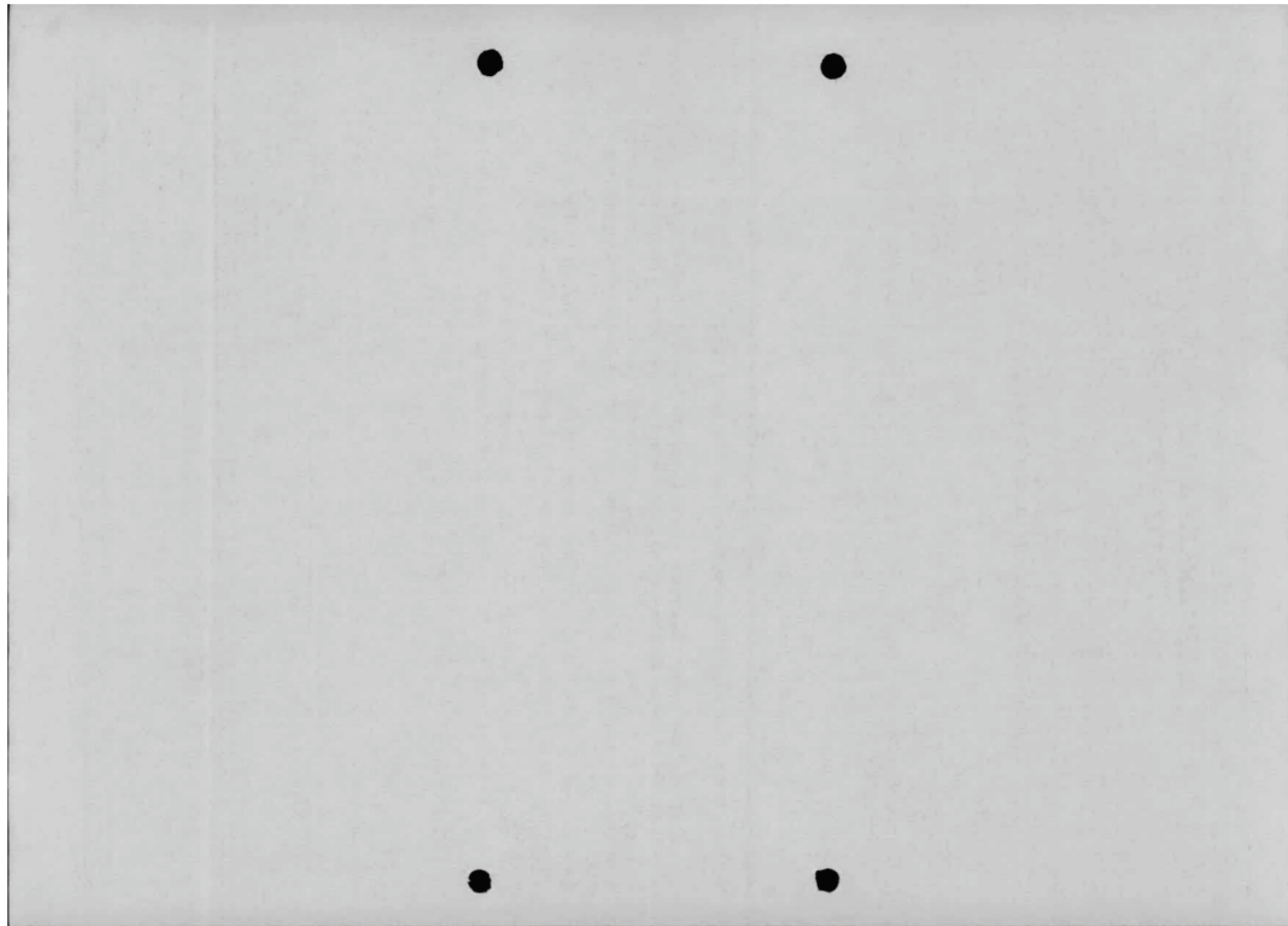
In view of her history and anxiety I would be grateful for a second opinion but did not refer her to the breast clinic as I did not feel this of such urgency. Thank you for your help.

Obviously if this is abnormal at all then we would need to try to see her again. If the smear is clear then she continues with the yearly smears for five years, if these are all negative she could then return to three yearly screening. I would be pleased to see her again if there are any further problems.

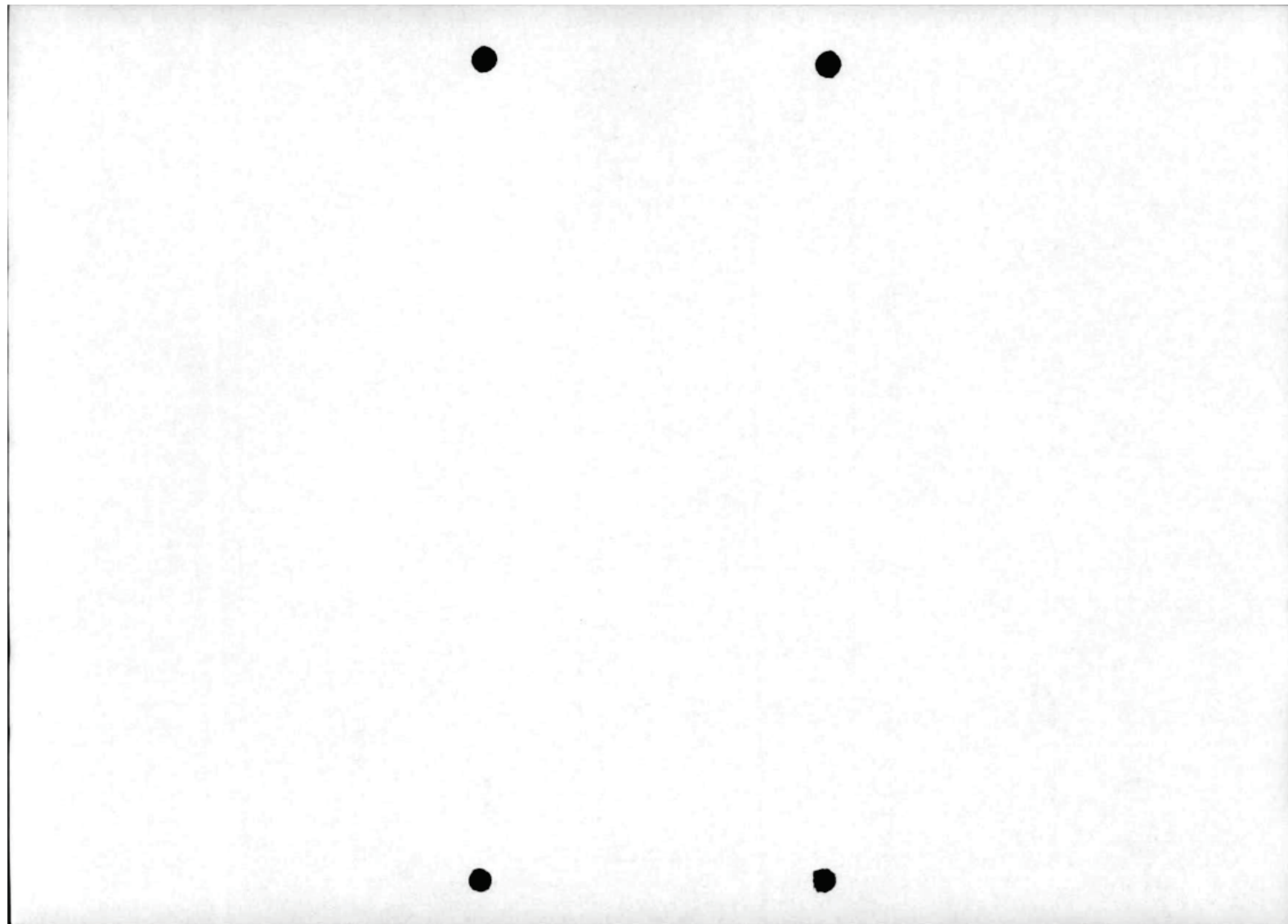
I have therefore asked the Health Board to remove your name and that of your children from our list and you should immediately make an appointment with another practice in order to register.

As you know it is very important that you have regular review in view of your previous disease of the cervix and I suggest that you contact Dr. Geals secretary at Dumfries and Galloway Royal Infirmary to update their records and arrange another appointment. They have also suggested that if there is difficulty you should contact your GP for a follow up smear.

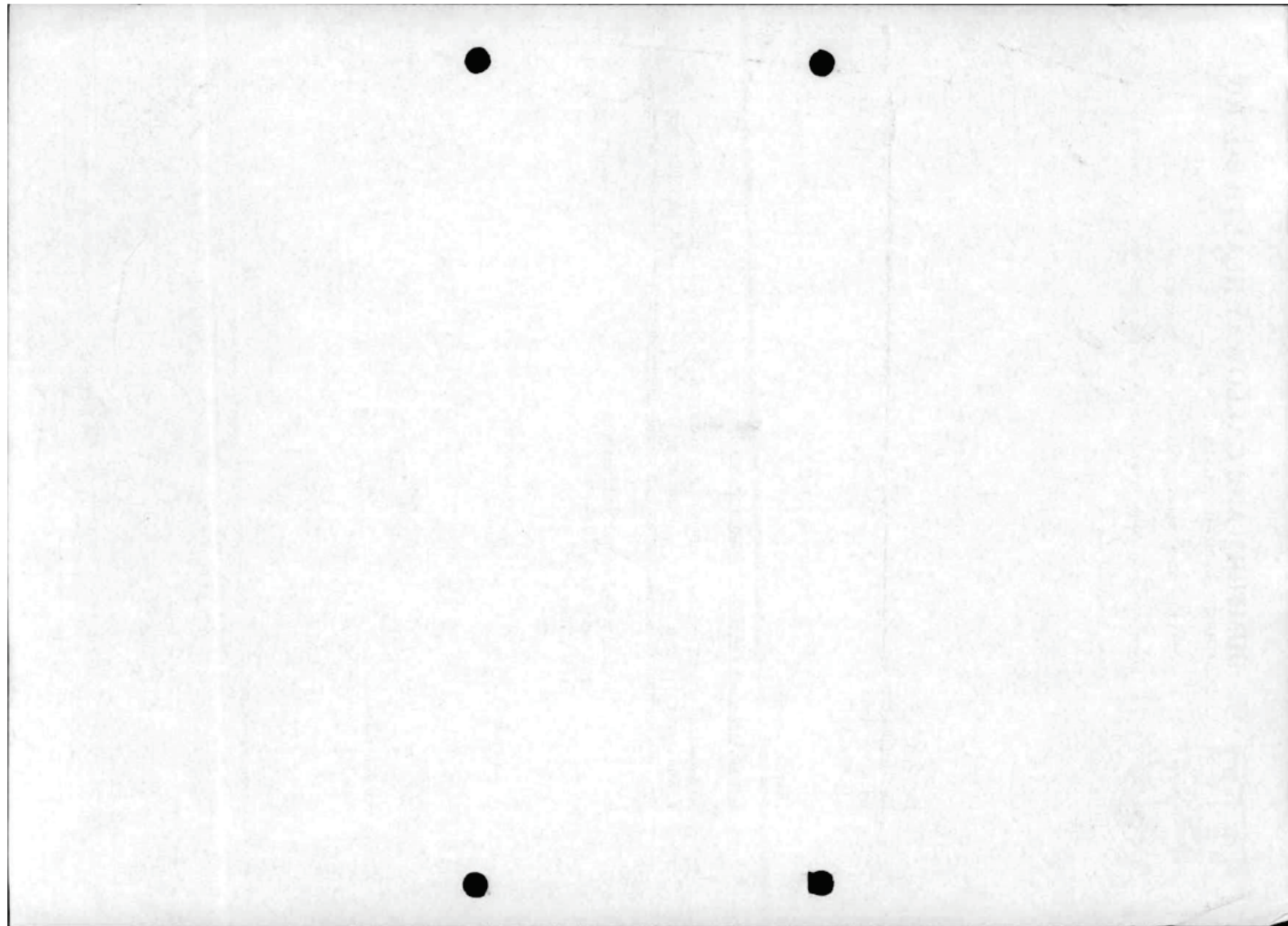

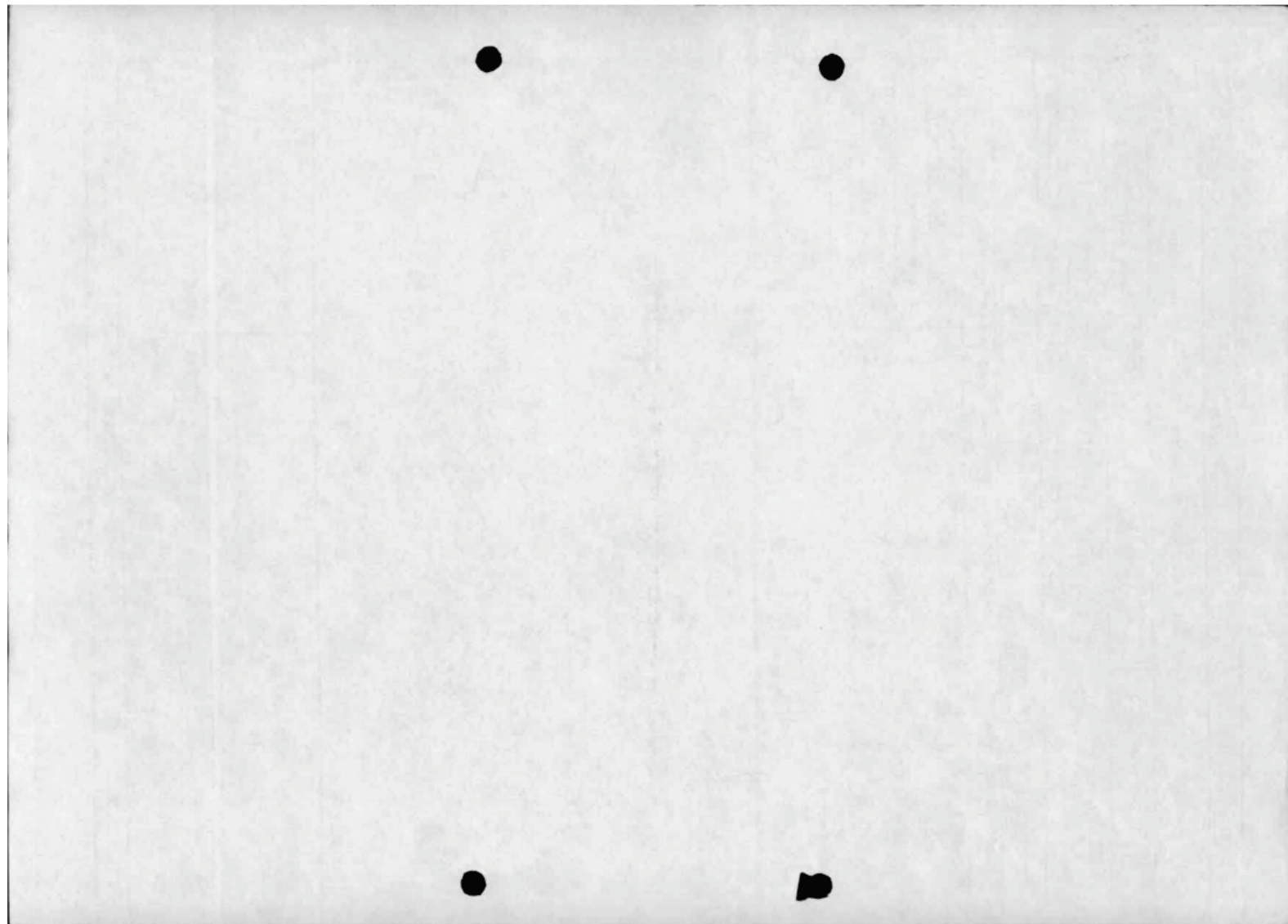


