Good afternoon,

Thank you for your previous email. We note its contents.

We understand the need for you to satisfy yourselves as to the identity of the data subject and our authority to act on their behalf. However, we have already provided:

- a signed Letter of Authority from our client;
- photographic identification confirming our client's full name and date of birth;
- proof of address;
- clear details of the Subject Access Request; and
- our firm's contact details as the authorised representative.

We are a regulated law firm and, as part of our own due diligence obligations, we have verified our client's identity before submitting the Subject Access Request on their behalf.

The ICO's guidance confirms that organisations should verify that a third party has written authority or power of attorney to make a request on behalf of an individual. In this case, written authority has already been provided. The ICO also recognises that further information may be requested where it is required to confirm identity or authority, but any such request should be necessary and proportionate.

In the circumstances, requiring a further signature solely for comparison with the signature on the Letter of Authority appears unnecessary and excessive, particularly where the passport and Letter of Authority confirm our client's full name and date of birth.

If you have a specific and reasonable concern regarding the validity of the authority already provided, please identify that concern clearly and explain what further evidence you require to resolve it.

Otherwise, please confirm that the Subject Access Request is being processed and that the statutory response period is running from the date on which the request and supporting documents were received.
