



After an explanation of confidentiality and the purpose of assessment, Mr Serapiglia told me he would like to give some background as he felt that this would help him more. He did so, but was happy to answer questions as required and to provide information for the assessment. Meets criteria for cPTSD. Re-experiencing with somatic arousal. Avoidance of

triggers and coping through avoidance and distraction. Damage to relationships (had been engaged three times and had never felt able to tell any of them); two "breakdowns"; drug use (cannabis) for symptom suppression; exhaustion and anger; problematic eating and difficulty setting boundaries.

I stated a Phase-based treatment approach but I was struck by what he was saying yesterday that he didn't believe he could get full benefit of the treatment until apology law and redress had been administered. I explained that it would be preferable that Mr Serapiglia was in a place to benefit from the intervention and not be left with a sense that it failed. Mr Serapiglia stated that he had a conversation with [REDACTED] Support Coordinator, Future Pathways and she had recommended that a mindfulness-based approach could be put in place, which Mr Serapiglia felt he would prefer at this time. I explained that I would discharge Mr Serapiglia and he could approach his GP for a re-referral but there would likely be a wait.

Trauma- nightmares few times/week, daily flashbacks - heart races, breathlessness, hot/cold sweats, pins and needles, avoidance of religion, certain foods. Self concept - "don't know who I am...flying by wire" Positive description of artistic then unable to say any more; negative description, horrible, agitated, isolating. Interpersonal - Suspicious of others, anything could happen - hypervigilance. Affect regulation - poor, "only way is to think of something nice." OCD - constantly cleaning house, car, self - if don't feel smelly, dirty, anxious, shameful, feel loss of control. No alcohol/substance issues. Meets criteria for diagnosis of Complex PTSD - offer phase based treatment. Mr Serapiglia stated he did not feel this intervention would have it's maximum benefit until after apology law and redress. He wished relaxation perhaps every 8 weeks. Agreed to have time to think about it and I'll call tomorrow. Can offer Stage 1 with Anchor or Relaxation (Mindfulness) through Future Pathways.

Described HS as difficult - underperformed due to trauma from past and current traumas. Unable to socialise with friends as helping father at work.

Jobs- catering, chef, Ice cream vans. Described difficulties in maintaining work due to impact of trauma.

Described hearing brothers at St Columba's beating a fellow pupil to death - continues to impact. Spoke of being retraumatized at recent criminal case and at the case being found 'not proven'

History of depression - saw Dr Mahmoud at Ross Hall for 15-20years - focusing on here and now. Saw Moira Docherty (Addictions counsellor) for 10 years - helpful with cannabis use. Currently seeing two counsellors - offering support to attend appointments - discussed that typically only one form of talking therapy at any time.

Meds - Sertraline, Propanalol

Initially Mr Serapiglia appeared anxious and we invited [REDACTED] who accompanied him to the session to sit in for the first 10 mins - Mr Serapiglia asked [REDACTED] to step out. Prior to leaving [REDACTED] stated that she felt that Mr Serapiglia's "life had never progressed into leading an independent adult life...he is in a depressive state a lot of the time."</p> <p>"I suffer terrible anxiety, everything is black in my world...I need redress and accountability, omce this comes I can learn to forgive other people." Mr Serapiglia went on to state that he experiences OCD based around his house, car and self. He noted the compulsions of cleaning were associated with flashbacks.</p> <p>Background information - born into happy family, mother, father, twin sister and older brother - age of 6yo-9yo went to Kildonan School, Girvan (Nuns of Cluny), all sibs together - physical and psychological abuse. From 9yo to 16yo St Columba's College, Largs (Marist Brothers) - all forms of abuse. At that point separated from siblings.</p> <p>Next assessment session 10/04/19 at 11am</p>
