1. That lack of parental care is likely to cause him unnecessary suffering or seriously to impair his health or development

and may, therefore, be in need of compulsory measures of care in terms of Section 32 (subsection (1) and (2)(c)) of the Social Work (Scotland) Act, 1968.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. Thomas was born on 14th July, 1973 and is the son of David Tarbett and Helen Lundie or Tarbett, who resided latterly at 41 Dunmore Street, Dundee. There are four other children, David born on 3rd December, 1967, Graham born on 27th January, 1969, Derek born on 6th April, 1970 and Lisa born on 7th August, 1974.
2. The parents have been known to the Dundee branch of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children since February, 1968. Since that time there have been frequent quarrels between the parents, leading to temporary separations on a number of occasions and causing unnecessary distress to the children.
3. On 12th October, 1979 David, Graham and Derek Tarbett were made the subjects of Supervision Requirements in terms of Section 44 of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968. Their case was brought to a Children's Hearing as a result of a referral under Section 32(2)(c) of the said Act and a copy of the Statement of facts is attached hereto.
4. On 5th November, 1979 Mrs. Tarbett left the family home and on 12th November, 1979 Mr. Tarbett abandoned the children outside a public house in Glasgow where he discovered his wife in the company of another man. Mrs. Tarbett returned to Dundee with the children and after spending three days in a homeless unit in Mid-Craigie, she was reconciled with her husband and the family returned to live at 41 Dunmore Street, Dundee.
5. On 4th January, 1980, Mrs. Tarbett again left the family home and did not return until 27th February, 1981.

6. On 13th August, 1980 Thomas was left unattended at Dundee Royal Infirmary after being admitted for treatment following a minor accident.
7. On 21st August, 1980 the children were left with neighbours at 40 Dunmore Street by their parents following a violent argument between the parents. Thomas and Lisa were admitted to care under Section 15 of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 but were returned home after the weekend.
8. On 15th September, 1980 Mrs. Tarbett left the family home. Mr. Tarbett requested help from Tayside Region Social Work Department and the children were received into care under Section 15 of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968. Thomas and Lisa were initially placed in Roineach Mhor Assessment Centre on an emergency basis but on 19th September, 1980 they were moved to Nimmo Place Children's Home, Perth. The parents were reunited on 26th September, 1980 and on 15th October, 1980 the parents removed the children from care despite advice from the Social Work Department to leave them in the Children's Home.
9. At the end of February, 1981 Mrs. Tarbett again left the family home. She did not return until 27th August, 1981 and then left again on Monday, 7th September, 1981, her present whereabouts are unknown.
10. On 9th September, 1981 Mr. Tarbett again requested help from Tayside Region Social Work Department as he could not cope with the children. On 14th September, 1981, Thomas and Lisa were taken into care, along with Derek and Graham, under Section 15 of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 and were placed in Burnside House Assessment Centre.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. David was born on 3rd December, 1976, and is the son of David Tarbett and Helen Lundie or Tarbett, 41 Dunmore Street, Dundee. There are four other children, Graham born on 27th January, 1969, Derek born on 6th April, 1970, Thomas born on 14th July, 1973 and Lisa born on 7th August, 1974.
2. The parents have been known to the Dundee branch of the Royal Scottish Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children since February 1968. Since that time there have been frequent quarrels between the parents, leading to temporary separations on a number of occasions, and causing unnecessary distress to the children.
3. On 20th May, 1976 Mrs. Tarbett pleaded guilty in Dundee Sheriff Court to a contravention of Section 12(1) of the Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act, 1937, and was fined £15.
4. In August 1976 the parents separated after a quarrel, and Mr. Tarbett requested the Social Work Department to take Thomas and Lisa into care as he was unable to look after them. However, Thomas subsequently went to stay with his mother, and the other four children remained with their father. The parents were reconciled in October 1976.
5. On 25th January, 1977 Mr. Tarbett was sentenced to four months' imprisonment, having been charged with assaulting his wife.

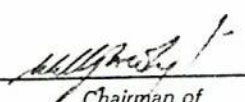

6. On 24th November, 1978 the parents again separated after Mrs. Tarbett complained of an assault on her by her husband. Mrs. Tarbett and the children stayed in the Battered Wives' Refuge in Dundee until 28th November, 1978, when they returned home.
7. On 8th January, 1979 Mr. Tarbett requested the Social Work Department to take David, Graham and Derek into care, as his wife had left the family home. Thomas and Lisa were being looked after by their paternal grandparents at 72 Drumlanrig Drive, Dundee. David, Graham and Derek were then placed in the Children's Shelter, 1 Laurelbank, Dundee, but Derek's behaviour there was so unruly that he had to be moved to Roineach Mhor Assessment Centre, Dundee. On 12th January 1979 Mr. Tarbett removed Derek from the care of the Social Work Department, and on the same date Mrs. Tarbett removed David and Graham. The parents were reconciled and the family reunited on or about 17th January, 1979.
8. On 27th January, 1979 Mrs. Tarbett again left the family home. In the early hours of the morning of 29th January, 1979 an officer of the R.S.S.P.C.C. was notified by the Police that Graham, Thomas and Lisa were in the care of a neighbour, [REDACTED] who was unable to cope with them any longer.

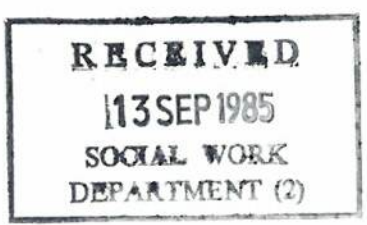
