Since the last review Tommy has remained resident in Carolina House.

The case was officially transferred to myself in June, 1985.

Within Carolina House, Tommy remains reasonably settled. His behaviour apart from minor incidents has been good and there has been only one serious incident when Tommy was [REDACTED] This is outlined in Carolina House's report. The incident was fully investigated and the families informed. Mr Tarbett's reaction appeared to be one of non concern. The rooms have been moved about to prevent a re-occurrence.

Since the last review Tommy and Lisa have continued their visits to their Grans every week. These have gone well but it has become clear that Mr Tarbett is not always present during these visits. "Granny" Tarbett after a long illness died recently. Aunt Kathleen is however present during these visits so they will be able to continue. Apart from these visits home Dad sometimes arrives at Carolina House unannounced but otherwise both he and the older boys have little contact.

Mrs Tarbett has had no contact with this Department for some time.

Tommy has transferred to Morgan Academy and appears to have settled down well there. He still enjoys football both playing and watching and spends much of his time involved in this.

He has no serious health problems but as with many others the annual medical has not been completed because of a dispute.
