Tommy was last reviewed on 30 March 1990 at Carolina House. At that time Tommy was staying in a self contained unit within Carolina doing his own cooking, budgeting, etc with a view to moving to independence.

In August 1990 Tommy moved to his present address at 10 Fintryside and his progress is fully outlined in Carolina House's report. On the whole this is going well and Tommy and his friend manage to organise the flat and the budgeting. Staff have daily contact with him, a situation Tommy has found some difficulty coping with. He has however recently been more able to accept the need for this. Perhaps because of this daily contact Tommy feels he doesn't want to cope with myself "intruding" and is too busy to see me. Given his busy timetable with sport, meetings at Carolina, etc this is perhaps understandable and it may be that my role could be a monitoring one with Tommy having the knowledge he can contact me when he wants. This is an area that can be resolved between myself and Tommy.

Tommy is a sensible youth who fills his time constructively. As well as his many leisure activities he has regular contact with his family and is able to continue this on his terms. He is a popular boy and his friends appear supportive to him in his flat.

He is currently a prefect in 6th year at Morgan Academy and is studying for three "H" Levels. He is still undecided about his future career, this depending on exam results.

Although not receiving a medical this year Tommy continues to enjoy excellent health.

FUTURE PLANS

As mentioned in Carolina's report Tommy's contract with Carolina as regards the flat will be reviewed in February 1991 to re-assess Tommy's continued required level of support and the next move to independence. He will continue at Morgan Academy studying for his "H" Levels.
