- Methadone is an addictive substance and can cause serious harm or death in overdose.
- Combining Methadone with other drugs and/or alcohol can cause death.
- Methadone can kill those who are not dependent on opiates (do not have a habit)
- Consumption of even a small amount of Methadone is likely to kill a child.
- State where extra doses of methadone will be stored.

PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:-

- During Methadone treatment, attendance at a named chemist within the allocated time slots is mandatory and no antisocial behaviour, theft or violence will be tolerated. Should this be reported, treatment will be withdrawn completely.
- Methadone will be administered by the pharmacist on their premises. Alterations to this e.g. For work or holidays may be considered following a period of stability, and any requests to change from daily supervision must be discussed with the keyworker and Doctor well in advance.
- If methadone is lost or stolen it is your responsibility to notify Police and Renfrewshire Drug Service. Your prescription can not be replaced.

RESPONSIBILITIES IN TREATMENT:-

- Failure to attend appointments and provide urine specimens as requested may mean that prescriptions will be withdrawn.
- Attendance at General Practitioners is required for all other medical needs. Wesley was admitted to Ward 3, Parkhead Hospital, Glasgow on 24th December, 2013 after presenting to A & E at Glasgow Royal Infirmary complaining of suicidal ideation. He has a history of Borderline personality Disorder, ex-intravenous drug use and low mood. He stated that his mood had dipped over the previous few weeks. It appeared that he had fallen out with his brother and father due to gambling away his benefits, despite owing them money. It seems that this had triggered his suicidal thoughts.

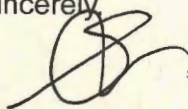
In addition, he stated that he had separated from his girlfriend a few months previously and that it was approaching the anniversary of his mother's death, which is always a difficult time of year for him.

On admission, he did not appear overtly depressed and had a reactive affect at interview. He stated that he was hearing voices, but that this had been "going on for years". He claimed these voices were saying "you've let your family down" and "you've nothing to live for". He stated that in response to this he had tried to throw himself in front of a taxi and that the driver of the taxi had driven him to A & E. He was adamant that if he was not admitted to hospital he would find a way to kill himself that night. He lives alone and was socially isolated due to falling out with his family.

There was no evidence of any psychotic symptoms on the ward and it was thought the voices that he complained of were not true auditory hallucinations. He denied any ongoing suicidal thoughts and was therefore discharged on 27th December, 2013 with follow-up from the Intensive Home Therapy Team in Paisley. No follow-up at Parkhead Hospital has been arranged.
