Assessment:

Thank you very much for referring this 45 year old gentleman. William runs his own business and works as a courier. He also works at foster-parent. He lives with [REDACTED] who does not live with him.

Since the end of June, William has had blackouts on an almost daily basis. He just passes out and does not have any preceding symptoms. He is out for a few minutes and the people, such as his son, who have witnessed this apparently say that he just has a mild shaking with his head.

He feels a bit tired, drained and confused after the event. There is no tongue biting. On a few occasions he has passed urine. The symptoms have had quite an impact in his life and have also unfortunately led to his partner ending the relationship and moving out.

William is also suffering with not being able to work as he is not allowed to drive yet which makes running his own business as a courier difficult.

Neurologically I did not see any abnormalities with this gentleman.

William though mentioned to me that he has increasing pain from his neck radiating into the whole right arm. He does occasionally drop thing and this pain is mainly a C6/7 pain. I just wondered if the patient possibly has a degenerative problem in his upper spine at C6/7 and have requested MR imaging.

I would appreciate an EEG although this will probably return normal as an EEG is only a shap-shot of the epileptiform activities of the brain at the time of the recording.

He smokes heavily at around 40 a day and alcohol is an issue with him. You mentioned in your referral from the 16.07.15 that the patient drinks 46 units. He drinks above this now after the separation from his partner and drinks between 50 and 60 per week. He is aware that this is over the limit and will try to reduce this.

Blood pressure hear today was 146/97 and pulse 97. H certainly did not have any clinical evidence for a postural hypotension. Given his headache history and these regular losses of consciousness now, I just wonder if we are looking here at any other syncope and have asked my colleagues in Cardiology to see the gentleman.

I do not think that these are seizures we are looking at. Probably he can take up driving quite soon again. At the moment I have him to stay off the road still pending the investigations I have requested today.

I will decide if a review with myself is needed after I have had the result of the tests back.

I am referring to William who suffers from blackouts of unknown cause. He was seen on 14.10.15 and my impression was that this gentleman that these episodes are not caused by epileptic seizures. The patient had an MR head on the 12.08.15 which was normal.

I referred the gentleman to cardiology and Dr Scott informed us on the 06.01.16 that the patient failed to attend his out-patient appointment.

I had a look at the nerve conduction studies which he had done on the 08.12.15 and these showed normal findings and no evidence for neuropathy or peripheral nerve entrapment. These nerve conduction studies were done because of the increasing pain from his neck radiating into the whole right arm. Also William mentioned that he drops things.

I firstly requested a MR C-spine which then cancelled as the patient is claustrophobic. I then requested an X-ray of his cervical spine and I was told by the Department of Radiology in Royal Bolton that the patient cancelled this appointment which was on the 22.11.15.

This patient also did not attend his EEG appointment at Salford Royal Hospital on 17.11.15.

No further action is needed by myself and if the patient has new or ongoing problems then please refer him back to our ICAT service.

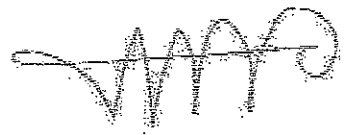

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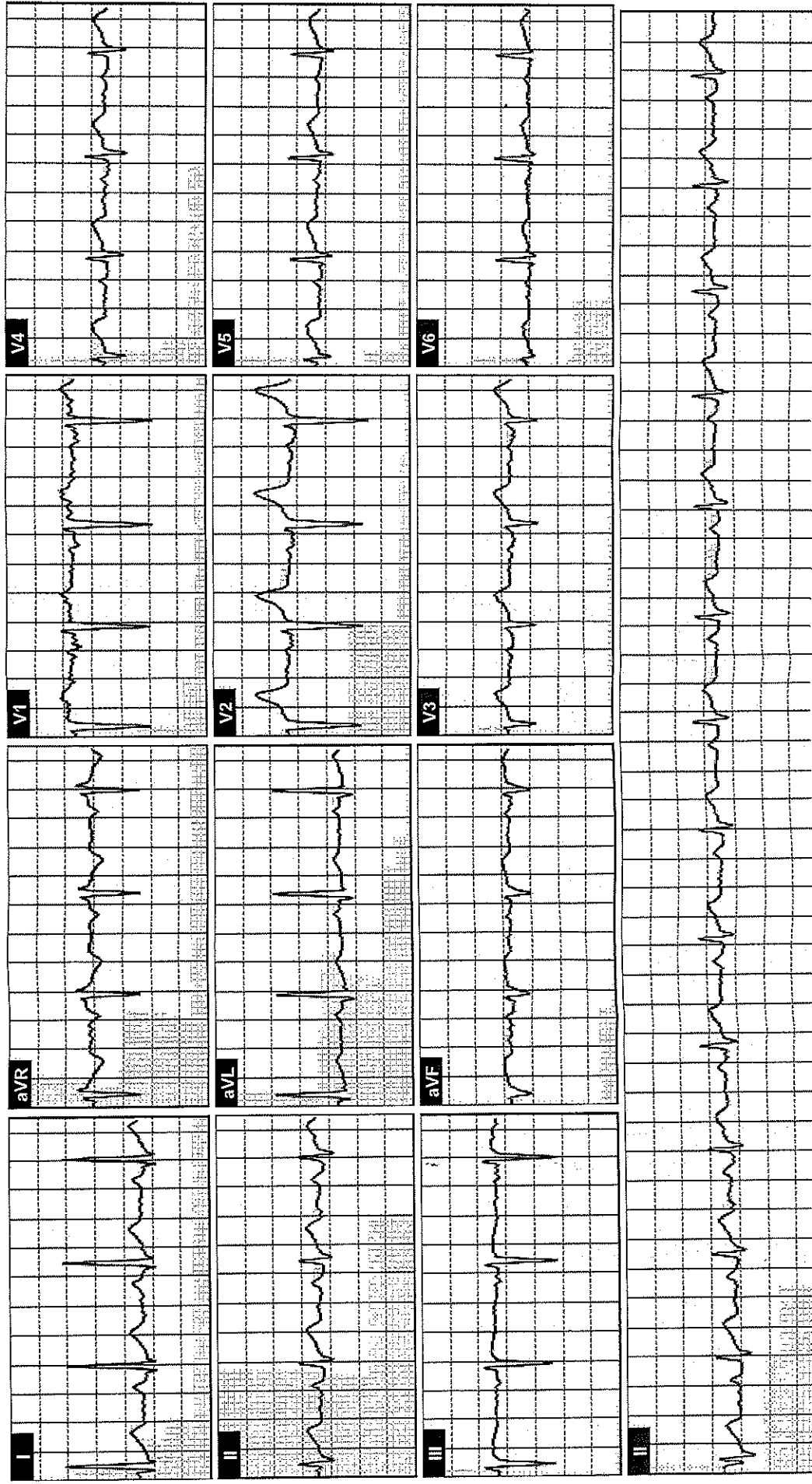

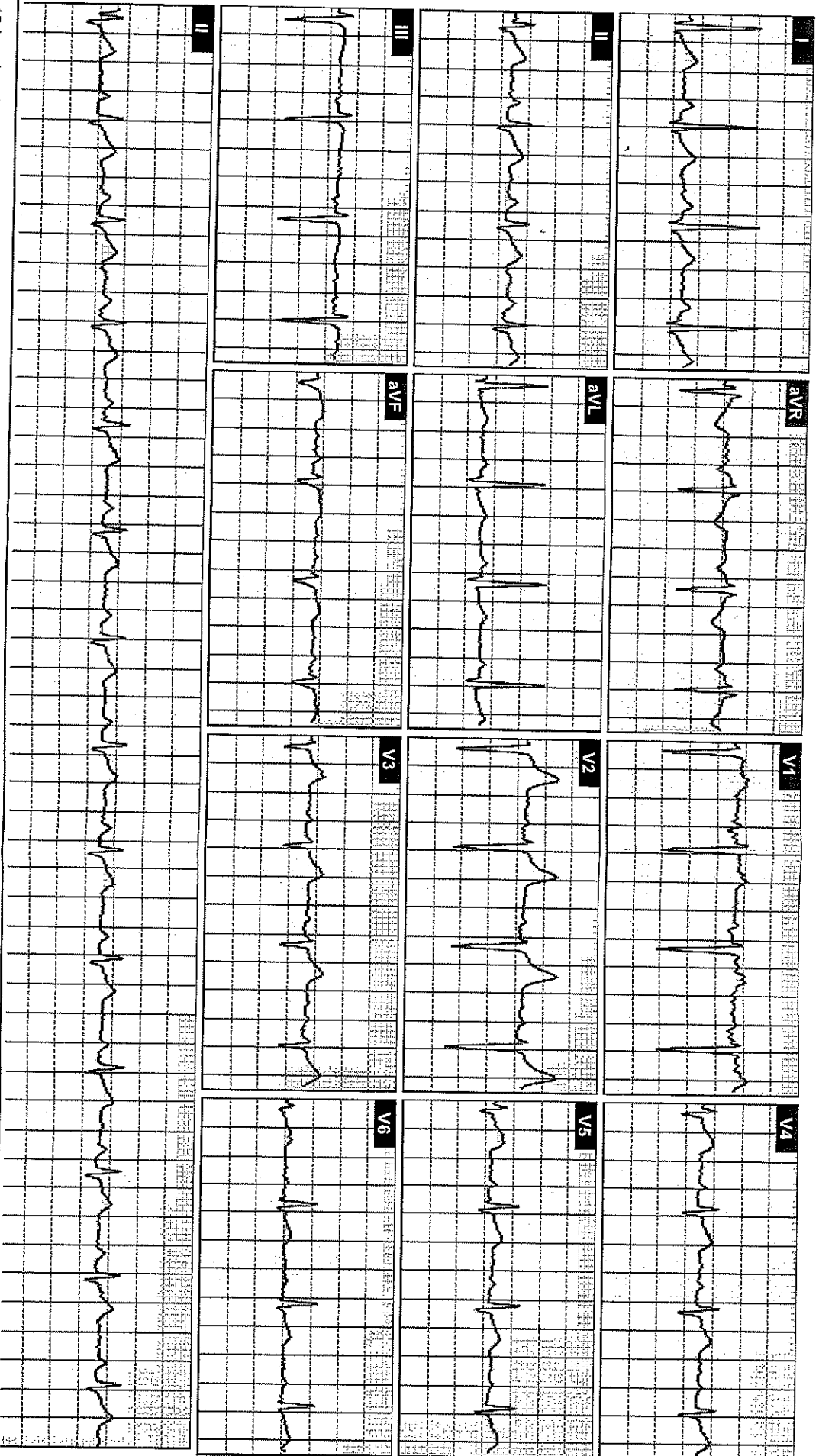
