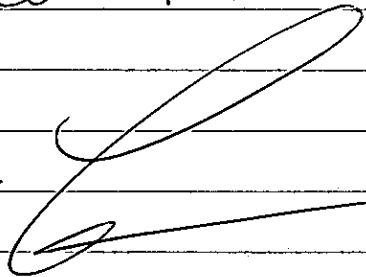

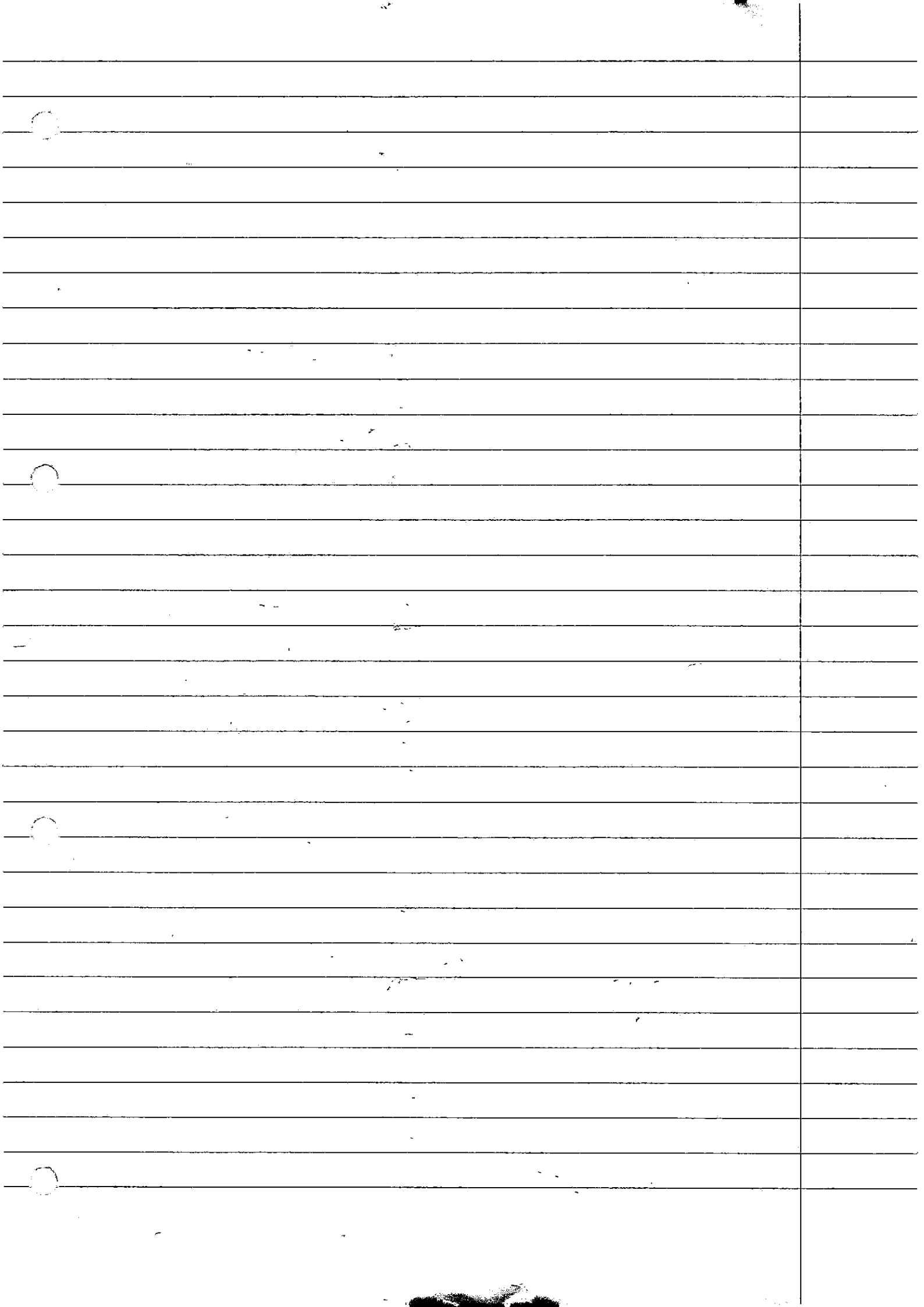

I am writing in my capacity as a support worker at Acorn house and a key worker to Mr. Colin Kerr. Acorn House is an abstinence based hostel (part of Spitalfields Crypt Trust) which provides residential treatment for drug and alcohol addiction. Colin checked into Acorn House on the 3rd December 2025. Prior to this Colin was sofa surfing/ street homeless. Colin suffers from alcohol and drug addiction, anxiety, and depression.

Colin is receiving treatment for his addiction which includes intensive daily group therapy in the mornings, therapeutic classes in the afternoon, weekly one to one counselling and key work sessions. Colin not only has addiction issues but also significant trauma from his childhood which has contributed to drug addiction, street homeless and various serious convictions.

His trauma relates to sexual abuse to Scotland in the early 1980s. Colin is currently receiving intensive therapy at Acorn house to address this.

Colin started using alcohol at the age of 14 left school at 15 years old. Colin then progressed to hard drugs cocaine and heroin. As Colin got older the problem intensified, he began getting in trouble with the Police and got many convictions.

Colin has got poor memory and concentration due to years of drug abuse, Colin says during one-to-one therapy he struggles because he may want to say something but before he can say it he loses it, he also drifts off during sessions and does not remember what is being discussed. Colin gets lost in places he knows and does not remember appointments. Colin is always reminded of appointments and medication time. Colin suffers from depression and anxiety this affects his motivation, sleep, and self-confidence Colin also gets extremely anxious around people, crowded or confined places like public transport he often gets panic attacks. When Colin is going through low moods he tends to isolate and self-neglect. Colin was referred to the mental health services has been prescribed Mirtazapine.

Colin also has poor physical health such as torn meniscus, back pain torn rotator cuff that restricts him from doing a lot of daily activities and functioning well. Colin has been referred to physiotherapy and knee clinic.

During Colin's active addiction before coming to the treatment centre, he would black out and would find himself in places he does not know, with injuries he did not know how he got them. During active addiction Colin got lots of convictions including car theft, robbery possession of dangerous weapons etc. All these patterns of behaviour shows that if Colin is not given the time and space to address his addiction issues, he is a very serious risk to himself and others.

Colin has now stabilised on his Subutex 8mgs daily. He has evidenced his none usage of illicit heroin by having negative urine samples. Due to his commitment to his programme it has been agreed that at his next prescription pick up on 2.3.12 that he will be commencing on BI weekly pick up.

Colin has been facing some very traumatic life events over the past 3 months. He has attended the inquest of his partner's death and he has had to come to terms with the adoption of his daughter. Colin has also recently reported historical sexual abuse to himself as a child. I initially contacted the Child Abuse Investigation Unit in Rayleigh and Colin is in the process of proceeding with this further.

Colin is on a Probation Order with Joe Kraylin Offender Manager and is on a DRR order with Westminster Drug Project, his worker is Zoe Salt. He attends Probation weekly for support so he does not reoffend and he attends DRR on a biweekly basis for oral swab testing and support. I liaise with Joe and Zoe as required. He has been very proactive with his order and has arranged all his appointments with CDAS, Probation and WDP so they do not clash and he is able to attend all of them on time.

Colin engages well in 1-1 care coordinator sessions and we are able to address his current problems and coping strategies and we are able to plan for relapse prevention and recovery. We have at times used Mapping Tools to assist this process.

Colin has commenced a Benzodiazepine reduction programme with his GP and is on a slow controlled reduction programme and has a copy of his regime and his dispensed bottles are clearly marked for clarity and he picks up his Diazepam bi weekly. Both Dr Kamel Consultant Psychiatrist and myself have liaised with his GP surgery regarding his presenting problems and his Diazepam reduction regime.

I have expressed my concern to Colin that he could return back to drinking alcohol as his Diazepam is reduced as this was the reason why he started to use Diazepam in the first place as he has previously had an alcohol dependency issue. We will continue to address this concern and possibility through 1-1 sessions.

Colin has commenced counselling with Britta Taylor counsellor at CDAS. She has stated that he is addressing many issues and has made a great deal of progress since commencing his counselling. She has stated that his counselling with her will be long term and will be reviewed as required.

Colin is very motivated and there is a marked change in his appearance and confidence since commencing on a programme at CDAS. He states that he feels more in control of his life and has great support from his sister and her partner and family friends. He wants to stop using substances and he wants to work but currently does not feel ready. He is going to start going to the Gym which has been paid for and arranged by Probation and he is going to look into college courses to meet new people and to gain more confidence and to gain a new skill.

Brief overview of case:

Colin informed me that he had been sexually, physically and emotionally abused whilst in foster care by his foster carer. When Colin wet the bed his foster carer would pull his genitals until they were sore, threatening to pull his penis off. I made a referral to the Child Abuse Investigation Unit in Rayleigh on 2.2.12 on the instructions of Colin to do so. Colin has since spoken to and met with the unit and the investigation is proceeding.

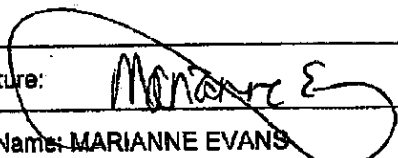

Dear Dr Persaud

Just to update you on Mr Kerr's progress since I last saw him on 10th January 2012, we were however concerned after meeting Mr Kerr on 19th January 2012 that he was confused with the number of tablets that he had to take on a daily basis. He told us that he taken 80mgs daily for the first 2 days instead of 40mgs.

We therefore recommend that you follow the enclosed prescribing guidelines and bottle separately each dose i.e. 10mgs, 2mgs and 1mgs in separate bottles. This to aid the client in titration plan.

In order to avoid him having an overdose as he was prescribed 2 weeks worth of Diazepam in one go. As you may be aware he is currently undergoing a great deal of distress due to having to cope with the inquest into his partners death and recent adoption of his daughter. It would be advisable that he collects his prescription twice in one week as per attached regime.

I reviewed Mr Kerr today - 10 January 2012 - in the presence of his Key Worker Marianne Evans CPN. As you are aware, Mr Kerr is a 32 year old gentleman, unemployed and lives alone (next door to his sister's accommodation). He is a poly-drug misuser, alcohol and opiate dependant.

Mr Kerr told us today that he uses between 30mg to 60mg a day of illicit Diazepam. He has reduced his drinking and last drank one can two days ago. He continues to be on Subutex 8mg daily and fortunately he has not used any heroin on top. We have informed him about the risk of overdose as Diazepam, Opiates and Alcohol are all depressant drugs.

Today we discussed a Diazepam reducing regime for which we are grateful for you to prescribe.

Plan:

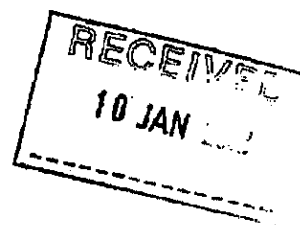
1. GP to action - Could you please prescribe Diazepam 40mg daily bi-weekly pickup, start reducing by 2mg every two weeks.
2. GP to action - When he reaches diazepam 30mg, could you then reduce his Diazepam by 1mg every week.
3. We will continue to prescribe Subutex and he will continue to receive support from our Counsellor (Britta Taylor) and Key Working by Marianne Evans.

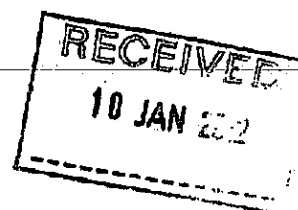

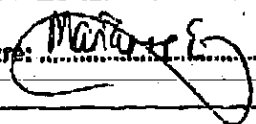

Please accept my apologies for this late letter but Colin was not sure when his car was in Wichford.

Review overview: Colin has just moved to this area to be near his sister. He has a 5 year history of heroin dependency and a 17 year history of alcohol dependence. The mother of his 7 year old daughter (Chloe) died in April 2011 from Phenytoin + Septicemia. His daughter has just been adopted. He has been buying street Diazepam 60-100mg daily to cope with not drinking alcohol and his anxiety. He was also buying Subutex so that he did not use heroin.

Review outcome: He has been commenced on a titration programme of Subutex with daily supervision. He has been given advice regarding reducing and stabilizing his benzodiazepines. He has been referred for counselling at CDAJ. Medication prescribed by CDAS: SUBUTEX 8mg DAILY SUPERVISED. Could you please inform us of any physical/psychological health issues & current medication prescribed for the above named.

I am writing to inform you that Colin was made homeless when his sister split up with her boyfriend and moved out of area. Colin was temporarily housed in Clacton via his Offender Manager, Joe Kraylin, at Basildon Probation. Probation have referred Colin and will fund him to attend a rehabilitation centre prior to his move out of area. He is awaiting a placement.

Prior to his move out of area Colin was stable on his substitute prescription of Subutex medication and had just commenced on bi weekly pick up from daily supervision of his medication due to not using any heroin since commencement of treatment at Basildon CDAS.

Colin had been on a Diazepam reduction programme with his GP but due to his housing dilemma and difficulty in coping with the reduction said that he had decided to come completely off his Benzodiazepines and return to drinking alcohol to cope with his anxiety.

Colin tends to either use Benzodiazepines or alcohol as he has suffered from acute anxiety since childhood and now uses either to help manage his anxiety. He has since recommenced on Diazepam and stopped drinking alcohol.

Colin's Criminal Justice support for his Probation and DRR order have been transferred to Colchester Probation.

Colin has now been transferred to the Drug and Alcohol Team, North East Essex (NEEDAS) for continuity of care and support.

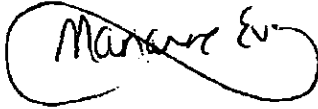

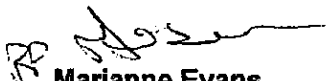

Brief Summary of treatment

Colin was commenced on Subutex substitute prescribing programme and has remained focused on his recovery and has not used any illicit heroin since commencement of treatment. Colin was stabilised on 8mg Subutex daily and as of 08.06.12 he has reduced his Subutex from 7.2mg to 6mg with the intention to reduce further prior to detox. In November 2011 he was commenced on a Benzodiazepine reduction programme in conjunction with CDAS and GP services. He stated that he could not cope with this reduction and rather than discussing this with his care-co-ordinator, Marianne Evans or his GP he returned to drinking alcohol from which he had not used since November 2011 and currently states he is drinking 2-4 cans of 5% lager (4-8 units) on a daily basis. He was recommenced on Diazepam by his new GP in Clacton on Sea on 20.06.12 and has now stopped drinking. Colin also commenced counselling with Britta Taylor, Counsellor at CDAS to address past childhood abuse, the death of his partner in April 2011, the adoption of his daughter and other significant life issues. He has currently disengaged from counselling. Colin is currently on a DRR order and Probation order and both orders have been transferred to Colchester Probation. Probation is also looking into funding Colin for rehabilitation.

As Colin is now living in Clacton I have transferred his care to the Drug and Alcohol Team North East Essex (NEEDAS) who picked up his care co-ordination and prescribing as of 05.07.12.

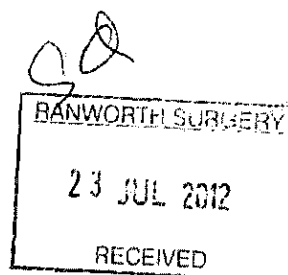

I assessed the above named patient at NEEDAS on 5 July 2012.

Presenting complaint and history of presenting illness

Colin informed me that he started drinking alcohol from the age of 14 and started using heroin and crack from the age of 27 years. He continued to use heroin and crack on and off until the age of 32 when his girlfriend died of septicaemia related to drug use. His use of heroin and crack was triggered following the death of his mother due to an accidental overdose of valium and morphine. His last use of heroin was more than a year ago and he last used crack more than 3 years ago. He uses cannabis very occasionally and last used cannabis a couple of days ago. He informed me that he has had alcohol problems since the age of 14 years and has suffered from delirium tremens and withdrawal fits. He informed me that he is currently not drinking on a daily basis and drinks on average 2 – 3 days a week. When he drinks he drinks a maximum of 2 cans of Fosters or Stella. Currently he is prescribed subutex 6 mgs daily which is dispensed twice weekly. He is also prescribed benzodiazepines 12 mgs daily and he is on reducing regime for this. He understands that his drug and alcohol use has affected his social, family and financial health. He is focused on keeping away from drugs. He admitted to injecting drugs in the past and last injected a year ago. He used to share needles with his girlfriend. He informed me that he has accidentally overdosed on drugs 3 times in the past; he has never received hospital treatment. He described his mood as up and down, he described his sleep and appetite as good. He was not suicidal or psychotic. He has been known to drug and alcohol services since October 2011 and before that he was buying illicit subutex and valium. He plans to go to rehab in Ilford.

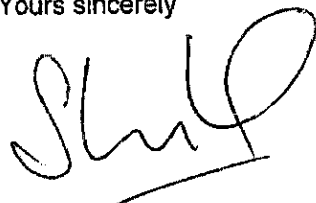
