20/11/00	JAMES O'NEIL, SOCIAL WORKER VISITED THE SCHOOL AND HAD A CHAT WITH DANNED ABOUT THIS WEEKEND'S VISIT TO STUART. DANNED VERY POSITIVE AND PLEASED ABOUT THESE ARRANGEMENTS. JAMES HAS ALSO PROPOSED A DATE FOR A MEETING WITH BILLY & JOE JEE WHICH IS MONDAY 14/12/00.

14/10/00	DAY PASS TO MUM'S PASSED WITHOUT ANY PROBLEMS.
16/10/00	OUT WITH JIM TO ROBBIE WILLIAMS CONCERT IN THE ARENA ARNOLD. HAD AN ENJOYABLE EVENING AND WAS ON HIS BEST BEHAVIOUR.
20/10/00	DARREN ENJOYED VARIOUS ACTIVITIES THIS WEEK AND DUE TO LOW NUMBERS EXPERIENCED A LOT OF 1 TO 1 WITH STAFF. THIS MORNING HE CUT HIS LEFT EYE WHEN BEING OVER THE RADIATOR IN HIS ROOM. ATTENDED THE SURGERY AND DARREN DID NOT REQUIRE ANY TREATMENT ALTHOUGH HE WILL HAVE A BLACK EYE. OUT TO CHRISIE'S FOR OVERNIGHT STAY & THEN TO MUM'S FOR ACCESS VISIT TOMORROW.
23/10/00	DUE TO TYPICAL LOSS OF CONTROL TODAY DARREN REQUIRED TO BE HAD BY STAFF IN BLAKE T.V ROOM. HE WAS SHOWN A WARNING CARD AND THIS THIS REQUIRED HIM SPENDING MOST OF THE EVENING WATCHING TELEVISION.
27/10/00	DARREN AGAIN ENJOYED A WEEK OF ACTIVITIES DUE TO THE TEACHERS BEING ON T.C.I. TRAINING COURSE. HE HAS BEEN GIVEN THE KING'S PHONE NUMBER (EX FOSTER PARENTS).
30/10/00	DARREN WAS OUT FOR HIS DAY PASS ON SATURDAY TO HIS MUM. ON HIS RETURN TO SCHOOL HE WAS WINDING UP [REDACTED] RESULTING IN DARREN GETTING A SORE FACE. 21/10/00	Not too bad a week for Darren although still lets his mouth run away with him. Day pass Saturday was to his mums.
4/10/00	Continues to provoke others resulting in (S.O.) another resident punching him on 2 occasions.
7/10/00	Out to Christie's for his overnight and then to mums for his few hours access visit. Returned to school at 5pm. Remember that mum started the day in a bad mood but improved and bought him lots of goodies. Later staff noticed a bruise on the top of Darren's right arm - like a grab mark. Darren stated it had been given during a wrestling game.
9/10/00	Attended children's hearing today and reports were fairly positive. Panel members recognised an improvement since Darren's admission to Ballyknaran.
13/10/00	Darren unsettled in school this week but most of the primary class are posing problems. In the unit the usual problems spending time in his room for his own protection. Incident on Wednesday (11/10/00) evening at shower time whereby he attempted to pull the towel off another resident (B.R.).

12/8/00	A MIXED REVIEW FOR DARREN TODAY WITH MOST PEOPLE RECOGNISING THAT HE HAS REGRESSED IN RECENT MONTHS. THERE HAS BEEN A SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN THE CLIENT GROUP AND THERE ARE NOW TWO BOYS IN THE UNIT OF A SIMILAR AGE TO DARREN. DECISIONS OF REVIEW AS FOLLOWS:- 1) DARREN TO REMAIN AT BALLIKIRKIN 2) JIM CLARK WILL CONTACT BILLY BONNAR, EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGIST REGARDING AN UPDATED ASSESSMENT OF NEEDS. 3) ACCESS WITH MRS DAWKIE WILL NOW TAKE PLACE IN FAMILY HOME WEEKLY 4) FUTURE PLANS WILL CONTINUE TO SEEK ALTERNATE FAMILY AS AN OPTION 5) SOCIAL WORK DEPARTMENT TO ARRANGE A HOME SUPPORT WORKER ON A SUNDAY TO HELP DEVELOPE DARRENS RELATIONSHIP WITH MUM 6) NEXT REVIEW WILL BE ON MONDAY 18TH DECEMBER, 2000 AT 2PM. NOT A GOOD EVENING FOR DARREN WITH SEVERAL INCIDENTS INVOLVING OTHER BOYS. EARLIER HE WAS PROMISED (C.C.) TO 'COME AHEAD', RETURNED FROM HIS FOOTBALL ACTIVITY EARLY, RECEIVED AN 8-45 PM BEDTIME AND WOULD NOT SETTLE BEING DEFIANT PUTTING HIS LIGHT ON AFTER STAFF HAD PUT IT OFF. THIS RESULTED IN THE OTHER BOYS HAVING A GO AT HIM VERBALLY AND AT LEAST ONE OF THEM HITTING HIM. DARREN THEN LEFT THE PLACE AND THREW A TRAINER WHICH HIT ANOTHER RESIDENT (J.T) ON THE BACK. DARREN HAD TO BE HELD FOR A SHORT TIME BY STAFF UNTIL HE CALMED DOWN.
15/9/00	A MUCH BETTER END TO THE WEEK FOR DARREN WITH A MUCH IMPROVED ATTITUDE.
16/9/00	DARREN OUT ON DAY PASS TO MUMS FROM 11-30am - 4-30pm

31/8/00	DARREN CONTINUED TO ENJOYER FALL-OUTS WITH OTHER BOYS TODAY AND SPENT SOME TIME IN HIS ROOM AFTER TEA. HAD ONE-TO-ONE ATTENTION WITH AWE DURING ACTIVITIES (IN THE UNIT) WHICH HELPED IMPROVE HIS DEMEANOR BUT QUICKLY RESORTED TO TARGETING OTHERS WHEN THEY LEANED.
4/9/00	OUT TO CHASSIE FOR FRIDAY / SATURDAY LEAVE AT THE WEEKEND. SHE REPORTED THAT SHE HAS RECENTLY LET DARREN GO SWIMMING TO THE PLAYGROUND ON HIS OWN. CHASSIE BECAME SUSPICIOUS WHEN DARREN RETURNED THIS WEEKEND WITH HIS TOWEL SOMEHOW WET AS IF IT HAD BEEN DIPPED IN WATER! ON QUESTIONING DARREN IT TRANSPIRES THAT DARREN DID NOT GO SWIMMING PREFERING TO VISIT CRAIGELLACHIE CHILDREN'S HOME AND CUNARD SCHOOL. DARREN ALSO TREATED HIMSELF TO A MCDONALDS AND INFORMED TO CHASSIE THAT A MEMBER OF STAFF AT CRAIGELLACHIE HAD GIVEN HIM £2 TO SPEND.
5/9/00	DARREN ATTENDED FOOTBALL TRAINING LAST NIGHT (AROSLAPPE BOYS CLUB UNDER 11'S) WITH WHITER AND ENJOYED THE EXPERIENCE - BEHAVIOUR VERY GOOD.
8/9/00	NOT A GOOD WEEK FOR DARREN CONSTANTLY TARGETING OTHER BOYS AND IN SEVERAL SCAPES DUE TO THIS. BEDTIME WAS 8.30 PM FOR THIS WEEK DUE TO HIS BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDE LAST WEEK. STRUGGLING WITHIN THE SCHOOL BLOCK AS THE PRIMARY CLASS ARE EXTREMELY UNSETTLED AND DARREN IS COMING UNDER A LOT OF PRESSURE FROM THE OTHER BOYS ALTHOUGH HE BRINGS A LOT OF IT ON HIMSELF.
19/9/00	DARREN WAS HOME FOR HIS DAY PASS ON SUNDAY FROM 11-30 AM - 4-30 PM

22/8/00	Overall it was a mediocre summer holiday for Darren with numerous fall outs with staff and other boys. There is no learning process at present as Darren continues to show abuse at other boys especially when staff are in the vicinity. He uses this as a form of protection hoping this will get other boys into trouble. Darren is finding it difficult in the unit due to the fact that there are now several boys of a similar age as himself.
	<u>Leave</u> - Darren did not have any extra leave over the summer period although Charlie Mcowan did appear a mo week overnight in July.
	He celebrated his ^{10th} birthday on Wednesday 26th July and his mum bought him the new Rangers strip. Darren bought himself a George & the Dragon pig ^{with} his money from the school.
	Darren attended his appointment at Yorkhill Hospital on Tuesday 13th July 2000 to have Gimmets inserted in his ears. Unfortunately his right ear has a perforated ear drum which will require an operation at a future date. He is to attend Yorkhill Hospital for a check up on Tuesday 31st October at 2-25 pm.
	Over the summer Darren's lip has flared up periodically requiring requiring treatment with Hydrocortisone cream. He was also prescribed powder to treat his athlete's foot.
	First day back at school and Darren has not had a good one. He was given numerous opportunities to redeem himself but failed miserably. His behaviour and attitude earned him an early bed.
30/8/00	Darren attended the dentist for a check-up today. James O'Neil, social worker visited with a worker from Cancellating Children's Home.

18.6.00 (contd) was an incident involving another resident during the visit. Mum complained [redacted] had hit Darren. When staff spoke to [redacted] he became aggressive and violent towards staff (Mary). It later emerged Darren had snatched the control pad for the computer from [redacted] who then hit Darren. (Anne Grier)

21.6.00 - Telephone message from Yorkhill Hospital. Darren's ear operation now to be done on Thursday, 13th July.

11.9.00 Darren is presenting himself very negatively at the moment. His behaviour amongst his peers is antagonistic, challenging and derogatory, which leads to constant intervention from staff to protect Darren from repercussions from his peers. He needs a high level of supervision as he continues to provoke the others in the unit through abusive remarks, underhanded comments etc despite constant advice from staff on appropriate ways of interacting with others. He has spent a fair time in his room as he ignores guidance and warnings over his unacceptable behaviour. He pays lip service to staff initially, but once reintegrated into group, he continues negatively.

His personal hygiene is appalling presently, barely getting himself well in a shower. He resents being told
