We also use CCTV systems for crime prevention.

This personal information can be both clinical and non-clinical in nature and can include

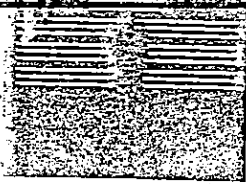

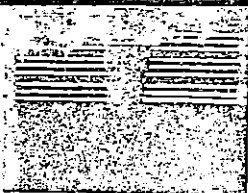
If you wish to continue attending the Hepatitis Clinic, you should ask your GP to request another appointment. We will only send another appointment at the request of your GP.

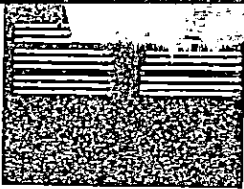
I saw this young man in my HCV clinic on 22 March 2001. We have confirmed him to be HCV PCR positive indicating ongoing viral activity but his LFT's are normal, which would suggest minimal inflammatory activity. He has been infected for approximately 5 years and is currently in residential drug rehab. Today I reassured him that although he remains infected with hepatitis C it is not currently causing any hepatic problems. I have advised that his priority should be his addiction problem so he will return in 6 months when we will repeat his LFT's and PCR.

I reviewed Kevin at Dr Fox's Hepatitis C Clinic today. He was referred up by a Medical Counsellor from Phoenix House where he is currently having drug rehabilitation. Kevin injected drugs between 1994 and November of last year, during which time he has shared needles with a number of people. He has no other risk factors for hepatitis C other than unprotected heterosexual intercourse. He reported he had never been tested for hepatitis B. He also had an HIV test in April of 1999 whilst in the local prison, this was negative. He has no significant past medical history and in particular has no history of epilepsy, psoriasis or mental health problems which can interfere with treatment. He is not on any current medication. He is a smoker of 20z of tobacco per week. He does not drink any alcohol. He is currently living in Phoenix House and has not injected since November of last year. He currently does not take any illegal drugs.

On examination today he looked well and there was no stigmata of chronic liver disease. Cardiovascular and respiratory examination were entirely unremarkable. Kevin and I had a discussion about hepatitis C and it's modes of transmission and treatment options. In the first instance I have repeated his hepatitis serology including hepatitis B and checked his other routine blood tests. I have also referred him to our Counselling Clinic, at his request for HIV testing. We shall see him back at our clinic in 6 weeks time.
