It would appear that there has been a change in Lewis' attitude within the classroom. A couple of teachers have brought to my attention that Lewis has struggled to remain seated in class opting to wander out of class. There has also been a noticeable change in his commitment to focus on classwork. This was however, challenged early on in the week and he has made an effort to improve. This will continue to be closely monitored with

At home and in the community: the option of 'behaviour cards' being looked at should he continue to push the limits.

Lewis met with mum on Thursday night followed by a meeting with dad. The main focus being to provide feedback on progress being made. However the issue of contact with mum on Sundays was discussed. Although Lewis stated that he would visit if

Important information: he wanted to both Carrie and John individually agreed to continue to encourage this contact as it was seen as an integral part of Lewis' care plan. The importance of remaining consistent with Lewis at school, with Carrie and with John was also very important. However, communication with the writer and Linda would have to be ongoing with both Carrie and John taking responsibility to feedback important information. As a result, consistency in all areas could be more effective.

### This week in school:

It was decided last week that Lewis should be placed on a behaviour card this week to monitor his behaviour. He was spoken to about this and understood the reasons why this was appropriate. However, Lewis did not co-operate with this at all. He refused to take on the responsibility to get his subject teachers to sign - when teachers asked for it he stated that he didn't have one. Although consistently encouraged both at home and by the writer nothing would change his mind. However,

At home and in the community: reports have improved slightly within school. If progress continued a behaviour card would not be necessary. However, should his behaviour deteriorate a behaviour card will be given to all class teachers to fill in comments and these will be sent to both parents.

No adverse reports from home.

### Important information:

Lewis struggled with the group on Thursday, this is a new group and we expect initial difficulties. However, this was the first session of the "Problem solving programme" and Lewis did not take part in the process of discussion and at times resorted to immature behaviour. As a result some of the other young people became angry with him. This was consistently dealt with by staff however, Lewis did finish the group in a negative frame of mind. He refused to discuss his feelings with staff and threatened to walk home.

An overnight stay at mum's has been organised for Friday the 7/5/99. He is completely aware of the expectations —

ie: time to be in at, conduct in community and early rise following morning to allow mum to go to work. This will be evaluated by all concerned before the next fortnightly overnight on the 21/5/99.

Camp on Monday - clear limits and boundaries have been reinforced to Lewis for behaviour and cooperation levels. If he or anyone else ignores these there will be very serious implications for the group on camp. The most important thing is that Lewis has lots of fun!

### This week in school:

Monday to Wednesday Lewis was on camp with the Extended Day Project to Glencee. This gave the group an opportunity to work together on various activities and problem solving exercises. Lewis did very well on the camp and took part in all the activities with a good level of motivation. However, he did let himself down when it came to helping with chores. He was spoken to on a number of occasions and eventually took this on board.

### At home and in the community:

First overnight at mum's on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> of May ended with Lewis wanting his friend to stay when denied he left the house and was missing into the early hours of Saturday morning. It turned out he was at a friend's house who was babysitting. Both Carrie and John phoned each other to solve the problem and did so by returning him home with John.

### Important information:

Lewis again refused to attend school on Friday no amount of encouraging would change his mind. Attendance therefore is a concern of the schools but more importantly is Lewis' poor attitude and poor level of cooperation.

### This week in school:

This has been a very unsettled week for Lewis. He was assaulted on Tuesday by another young person in his class who was subsequently charged. He took Wednesday off and returned to school on Thursday. However, we had numerous complaints from teachers stating that he was being disruptive, uncooperative and was constantly missing from class. Although the conflict between Lewis and the other young person had been resolved by senior management it was felt that he may still feel intimidated, although he stated this was not the case.

### At home and in the community:

Lewis spent Thursday night at mum's as dad is away for the weekend. Lewis complied with mum's requests and was in for 10pm with no problems arising. Dad will collect Lewis on Saturday / Sunday.

### Important information:

Lewis was displaying some very immature behaviour at the group on Thursday night. He had a very unsettling influence on the rest of the group by being generally unco-operative, aggressive and completely off the wall. He was given clear boundaries and members of the group were also not impressed by his behaviour. He will need to start next week in a better frame of mind if he is to progress in the project / school.
