	<p>Lewis has shown great improvement both in his level of attendance and in his efforts while in class. Lewis began a new time-table this week which allowed him mornings in Education and afternoons at the Youth Art Project which includes more practical skills. This is a very individualised package which has been presented for Lewis and in the initial stages he has shown a commitment to working with this package. He did on the other hand slip up on Friday morning when he left the school grounds with another young person but was reported by local neighbours and retrieved by staff. Lewis was spoken to by both myself and his mentor at Youth Art with regards to the consequences that could occur from repetition of this behaviour and also to reinforce the positive outcomes of his week to ensure this does not become a pattern.</p> <p>Both at home and in the community Lewis continues to do well. With Lewis attending school on a regular basis life at home is more structured for both John and Lewis.</p> <p>The only other issue brought to my attention after Lewis left the school on Friday was that there is an problem with him putting his seatbelt on in the taxi. This is a matter of health and safety and if the problem persists Lewis may not have the luxury of a taxi to and from Kibble. 7-2-00 LEWIS INVOLVED IN AN INCIDENT WITHIN HIS TAXI ON FRIDAY AFTERNOON WHICH RESULTED IN THE TAXI REFUSING TO PICK HIM UP THIS MORNING (MON 7-2-00), JEAN LOGAN AND SUSAN SMITH SPOKE TO THE TAXI DRIVER TO ASCERTAIN THE FACTS OF THE INCIDENT:

- 1) NOT WEARING SEATBELT;
- 2) ALLEGEDLY DRINKING IN TAXI (NOT ALLOWED);
(JUICE)
- 3) " SMOKING HASH; (" ")
- 4) VERBALLY ABUSIVE TO DRIVER;
- 5) KICKING DRIVER'S SEAT;

LEWIS ADMITTED THAT HE DID NOT WEAR SEATBELT SOMETIMES, DRANK IN THE TAXI, VERBALLY ABUSIVE TO DRIVER, KICKING SEAT & HE STATED THAT HE HAD NOT SMOKED HASH AND DID LEAVE TAXI AT END OF JOURNEY. ~~LEWIS~~

LEWIS'S ALLEGATIONS RE TAXI DRIVER WERE:

- 1) VERBALLY ABUSIVE & COLLECTED PRICE

- 3) DRIVER TRIED TO ABANDON 2 BOYS OUTSIDE BEITH

2-May'00	<p>Contacted Lewis by telephone as he had not attended school today. He said that he had injured his leg (Bruised knee cap). I informed Lewis that he will require a note from John stating that he has an injury, Lewis said he would bring this in with him tomorrow (3-5-00).</p> <p>John is content with the progress Lewis is making, and although I offered to do a home visit this evening, John felt he could cope cope with Lewis on his own. John continues to enjoy his new job and could possibly get a full time contract out of it.</p> <p>John & Lewis received the documents I sent last week and appreciated the clarity of information regarding the days left of school.</p> <p>Ann Johnson had also written to Lewis as was agreed.</p> <p>Told Lewis the exams dates and said I would send them in writing.</p> <p>I arranged a closing visit with John on 9th of May, and agreed to meet with Lewis in school to arrange an activity.</p>

4-May-00 - Lewis brought note from dad, confirming that he had a sore knee & was unable to attend school due to poor mobility.

4-5-00 Kenjworth/Gnding line this afternoon. Went to Army/Mary store which Lewis appeared to enjoy. As saw the mast of a tall ship and seemed keen to go back and see it. The tall ship was interesting and I believe Lewis enjoyed the exploration of a tall ship. Throughout the afternoon we had a general talk about how things were in his life at the moment, and how his work and exams were coming.

He seemed positive about the exams and said he would try his best. The relationship between himself & mum sounds like it has improved, he often referred to the material items in his Mum's new home eg mercedes cars, 21C flooring just fitted. On the whole it was positive, Lewis had seen a jacket that he liked, we agreed that if he did well in school I would take him back to the shop on the following Friday.

I explained to Lewis about the new care plans I agreed with him that John & himself discuss it at home.

5.5.00 TK A. Johnson - not available

5-5-00 - Lewis refused to attend school: John called to say that L. had been verbally & physically aggressive towards himself.

After a lengthy call the following information was extracted from the conversation.

On Thursday evening Lewis began to go into a "mood" as John had said he wouldn't be able to take him to get the jacket Lewis had seen, but did say that he knew Lewis could take Lewis to the shop in Alagen on Thursday.

Friday, refused school, very verbally aggressive towards John, smashed up a chair with a hockey stick, generally aggressive and mood.

John felt he had to cancel his shift of work as he felt Lewis could not be left whilst displaying this behaviour.

John & I discussed the possible plan of action. Grounded, pocket money deducted, no extras.

L. I agreed to contact John on Monday.

TK - to Mrs Johnson - she agreed to meet with John, Mum, Lewis next weekend.
