He returned after dropping the other two boys off at his ex-wife's as during the journey Lewis had called his dad on the mobile phone and was verbally abusive towards him.

On return to the house dad found that Lewis was up and dressed and that he had also trashed his bedroom. Shortly afterwards Lewis left the house shouting a torrent of abuse which was directed at Dad.

we agreed to give Lewis until 10.30am before taking any other action. Duty manager, Gerry Daly, fully apprised of above.

9am - TLC from Lewis's dad. Lewis now at home and is tidying his bedroom. Writer spoke to Lewis who assured that there would be no repeat of his behaviour. Advised Lewis to speak through this morning's events with dad and try to resolve differences. Lewis's dad assumes that this was all over the fact that Lewis did

not want to get out of bed. Dad will speak
with Kibbole staff at the beginning of the
week.
